We were able to finish our furlough meetings by the end of July and start the new ministry as of August 1st. This way I was able to help two churches during August and also be in two preacher's meetings to let the pastors know of Shepherds Care. I've been told repeatedly "It is a needed ministry."

Also during July/August we began setting up household in the US – something we had not had in over 30 yrs. We are now living in Ohio, and working from here.

During August, I was able to take care of my 88 year old father while my sister and her family went on vacation. This was by far the most time we've spent together in over 35 years. We had a wonderful time together, and I was able to take my dad to church that Sunday: his first time since moving to Pennsylvania.

Already in September I've been in two more preacher's meetings and four more churches. Also, October is already booked up helping small churches and churches with bi-vocational pastors, and attending the Lighthouse Legal Seminar.
