We thank each of you for your faithfulness to our Heavenly Father, for your faithfulness to pray for our ministry, and for your faithfulness to support us financially as we press toward the mark that is before us. We will continue to keep you in our prayers as you continue to minister where God has placed you to serve.

As we closed out our furlough we were blessed to visit many more faithful, supporting churches. We connected with old friends and made new ones. God was good to us as He refreshed our spirits at E-week at BIMi and at each church that we had the joy of being with. He also provided in amazing ways by allowing us to meet new friends and visit new churches. He even led one of them to take us on for financial support and two others to take us on for prayer support. It is amazing to us every time God provides for our needs in ways we do not even plan for but He sees all along. All He asks of us is that we trust and obey as we follow His direction for our lives.

During this period of reporting we have had part in seeing six souls come to know the Lord as personal Saviour. One little girl was saved after a message I preached at one of our supporting churches. While preaching, I called on her brother to help me with the illustration. It was neat to see how God used the whole experience to call out to her and show her her need for the Saviour. We were all excited and were rejoicing with her and her parents after the service. In fact, we were so excited, we ended up leaving our flash drive with our presentation at the church and they had to mail it to us that week! Again, thank you for your faithfulness to pray for us. Please pray for us as we continue to serve here in Yokosuka. Please pray for the men and women of the U.S. Military as they protect our freedoms.
