Since early August, Randy has had the privilege of teaching an online college-level class to 20 Khmer students from six different churches throughout Cambodia. This institute was started by veteran missionary Rodney Ruppel and is currently in its inaugural year. The institute is designed to equip Cambodians to become lay leaders and pastors in their local churches.

Randy's class material is split into two topics: true religion, and false religion. During the first half of the semester, we focused on 1,2, and 3 John with an emphasis on how to distinguish between true and false religious teachers. The second half has been focused on surveying various cults in Asia and around the world. We are thankful to hear reports of students learning and being equipped to contend for the faith.
