

Bolivia Update - November 2024

Dear friends and prayer warriors,

Greetings in the name of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ!

Time is really moving on. It is getting nearer to a great time of the year - Thanksgiving!

Looking back, we all have a lot to be thankful for. This newsletter is a reminder of God's provision for many people that are shown in these pictures.





There are many others who have received radios, but we don't have pictures of them because they live in remote areas.

This praise letter is a bit different, because we need your help. For my next trip to Bolivia in January our goal is to purchase 100 radios, 2,000 microchips and plastic boxes to put the microchips in.

We have a huge prayer request. These solar radios have become very popular, so the supply that comes to Bolivia gets sold out very fast. We have a buyer who keeps watch for the incoming supply. A goal of 100 is divided among three different language groups. In each language group the population is roughly 8,000 persons, scattered in various parts of the jungle areas. We are trying to reach as many as we can, especially in these remote areas.

The radios cost approximately \$40 a piece which includes several microchips, a plastic box, and the cost to ship them to these isolated areas.

Our job will be to make the trip to Bolivia, load the many microchips, check all the radios we buy, package them in boxes, and ship them to various locations. Then designated people will get them out by bike, canoe, walking, and some by plane. It is a process well worth the effort. God's Word is arriving in their homes and communities, and they all say thank you!
