



Greetings and Happy Thanksgiving,

We first want to thank the Lord for His goodness, grace, and mercy throughout the year so far. Psalm 136:1, "O give thanks unto the LORD, for he is good,: for his mercy endureth for ever." As I write this letter today, we are in the US for an extremely short 9 week furlough, visiting 25 churches. I regret the fact that we cannot see everyone that we really do want to see, there was a necessity to visit the ones we did. I know that most understand what missionaries go through making these decisions, and we appreciate the grace that you give to us. For those wondering, we will get to visit family briefly for the holiday and get back on the road to finish our meetings. We are looking at a bit longer furlough in 2026, and will really try to get to those we have not seen in a very long time. That said, the work in the Netherlands is going well in our absence, but we are looking forward to getting back soon and getting back into the ministry there.

November 2024

God has blessed us with protection as we have travelled. We had a real close call in Nebraska on the interstate, but God kept us safe, and we got to the next destination. The church services in the Netherlands are going on as planned. God has blessed us over the years with several men that have the potential to teach and preach. I have 3 men alternating preaching, 3 other men alternating the Sunday School lessons, and others teaching the teens. From the reports we see attendance is down, but the services are going well, and the people are becoming closer to each other. Some of the men filling the pulpit are the ones I've mentioned in the past as having the potential to start works in other parts of the country in the future. There are still visitors coming while we are away, and I have heard that one new family is coming almost every week. We have been able, with WhatsApp, to continue discipleship with one of our groups, but the rest are on hold until we get back. Since we have been away, there has been some violent anti-Israel protests at the same location we do our street ministry. Pray for the protection of that ministry during this time.

Please pray for the ministries there in The Netherlands while we are away, that maybe God would confirm a call to some of the men. Pray for us as we finish up this short trip, that we have safety on the roads, and that we can avoid bad weather. Pray that our flights go smooth for our return to the Netherlands on December 26. Pray for continued good health while we are travelling. Pray that we can encourage the churches we are able to see. Pray for each other!
