In the last couple of months, I have had the privilege of leading two ladies to the Lord. One of the ladies, I have been working with for many months. She was attending Jehovah's Witness Meetings and asked me on one occasion some questions and I gave her Biblical responses. When she came to me and said she was ready to receive Christ, it was such a joyful time. I am now discipling her and she is truly excited to see all that God has done for her. It is such a privilege to help her grow in the Lord. The other lady grew up reciting Scripture and thought that would, "get her into heaven", I was able to share with her the true way to receive Christ and I am now discipling her as well.

MEDICAL MINISTRIES

The last couple of months, the Lord has brought several medical needs across my path. To name a few: a young mama in pre-term labor, then just a few days later to the same home the new baby had a high fever and low oxygen level. A young child with asthma in respiratory distress. A lady in a hypertensive crisis (blood pressure 202/120) at one of our health screenings with stroke-like symptoms and no way to the hospital. Just this past week I met an elderly mama at the orphan ministry who came for a health screening who had a wound on her leg. I asked her what had happened, and she said she got bit by a dog *2 years ago*. When I asked to look at the wound, I was amazed at the fact that this mama was living like this for 2 years. The Lord laid it on my heart to help this mama. This week, I started going to her home and dressing the wound, hoping to get the wound to heal.

Please pray with me that it will heal and through the process, she will see the love of Christ. It has opened my eyes even more to the needs here in Port Elizabeth for medical missions. There are so many people just like her in need of help, physically and more importantly spiritually. **The need is so great.**

That brings me to my need for a medical clinic. At the end of November, the house that our church had been renting was sold. We **NO LONGER** have a facility in the Walmer Location. Please pray with us (myself and the Womacks). This is where we did medical ministries, soup kitchens, holiday clubs, Bible studies, etc. We are currently looking for a facility.

I am praying about and would like to start raising funds for a MOBILE CLINIC. A mobile clinic costs about \$80,000-\$100,000 USD (cost difference due to exchange rate and vehicle costs). Here is a link to a mobile clinic similar to what I am looking at MOBILE CLINIC.

While a permanent facility is still needed, a mobile clinic would allow me to go to all areas of Port Elizabeth. The different medical needs that I have described in this letter and in the last have been in many different locations. Many times, the living conditions are not ideal, and the sanitary conditions are not fit for proper medical treatment. A mobile clinic would allow me to take a patient into a clean environment to offer them medical treatment no matter where they are located. Please consider how the Lord will use you in this ministry: uThixo ulithemba (God is Hope).
