

**Housing For Older Persons' (HOPA)

Under Title VIII of the Civil Rights Act of 1968 (The Fair Housing Act), as amended by the Fair Housing Amendments Act of 1988, The Housing for Older Persons Act (HOPA), signed into law in 1995 defines housing for older persons as housing intended and operated for occupancy by at least 80 percent of the community or one person 55 years of age or older per unit. To keep a housing community or facility for older persons, the Statues require that Associations claiming the exemption establish age verification procedure.
