In 1990 I brought the tractor to Arizona after purchasing my first property. The tractor was returned to Iowa while I was in California for a short time 1999 to 2005. During this time the tractor was to be overhauled.

So, when we found out the real condition the engine was in, I gave him the go ahead to pick it up and proceed with his plan. The original plan was to use a 4.3L Chevy V6 but they proved to be hard to find and very expensive. Plan B, a 2.8L was used instead and worked to be a much better fit.
