People who reach others for Christ are ...

Available and obedient to God.

1. Even though they do not know and understand everything. (23, 28)
2. Even though the person they are talking with does not know and understand much or anything about Christ. (30-33)

Christlike in relating to others.

1. Be humble. (25-26)
2. Truly accept and be ready to share the gospel with everyone. (27, 34-35)
3. Directly and clearly proclaim the gospel. (36-41)

Committed to establishing new believers.

1. Accept them as equal fellow-believers. (44-48)
2. Invest in their spiritual growth. (48)

In My Life This Week

As you use this daily guide, write out your observations and responses on a separate piece of paper and save them with this sheet for reference.

Monday. We have taken three looks at 9:31 - 10:48, which records the church moving out to Gentiles with the gospel. While it is a lengthy section, read it now to get the overall picture of what God was doing here.

Tuesday. Last Sunday as we looked at Peter bringing the gospel to Cornelius, we drew out the portrait of people who reach others for Christ. Peter was available and obedient to God even though he didn't know or understand everything and Cornelius didn't know the gospel. As you review this, write out some specific ways in which you will be available and obedient to God as a witness, in spite of all you don't know and understand.

Wednesday. Peter shows us that to reach others for Christ we must be Christlike in relating to them. Review the three qualities listed on the outline. Where are you with respect to them? Where do you need to grow? What steps will you take to do that?

Thursday. Peter also demonstrated that we need to be committed to establish new believers. This is important for you, not just the pastors or other church leaders. How are you investing, how can you invest in new or newer believers?

Friday – Saturday. On Sunday we plan to look at *The Art Of Solving Conflicts* from Acts 11:1-18. Read and think through this section in preparation for our time together.
