



NEVERTHELESS - HOWEVER

¿Alguna vez se ha usted preguntado cómo usar la palabra "nevertheless" en una oración? Este es un adverbio que se usa a menudo para introducir una afirmación o idea que contrasta y que significa “sin embargo”, “a pesar de”, “aún así” y se usa comúnmente para indicar un cambio de pensamiento o para enfatizar un punto que contradice la información anterior. "Nevertheless" puede conectar eficazmente dos frases u oraciones, resaltando una diferencia de ideas y manteniendo la coherencia general del texto.

Ejemplos:

1. The book was long, nevertheless I read it all.
2. I don't like vegetables, nevertheless I ate them.
3. The rain was pouring, nevertheless they played outside.

¿Cómo usar "nevertheless" en oraciones?

Práctica: Para sentirse más cómodo usando "nevertheless", intente incorporarlo en tus conversaciones o escritos cotidianos. Preste atención a cómo afecta el tono y el flujo de su oración.

En conclusión, "nevertheless" es una palabra versátil que puede añadir profundidad y matices a sus oraciones al introducir una idea o perspectiva contrastante. Con la práctica, podrá usarla con confianza para mejorar sus habilidades comunicativas.
