For more than a century, Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Incorporated® has been on the leading edge of progressive programming for African American communities, and today AKA is still the model of women using their strength to soar to greater heights.

Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Incorporated® was formally organized on the campus of Howard University in Washington, DC, in 1908 and is the oldest Greek-lettered organization established in America by women of color.

The five basic tenets of Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Incorporated® are to cultivate and encourage high scholastic and ethical standards; to promote unity and friendship among college women; to study and help alleviate problems concerning girls and women to improve their social stature; to maintain a progressive interest in college life; and to be of "Service to All Mankind." Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Incorporated® is a globally impactful organization with over 300,000 members committed to enriching minds and encouraging life-long learning; providing aid for the poor, the sick and under-served; initiating social action to advance human and civil rights; working collaboratively with other groups to maximize outreach on progressive endeavors; and continually producing leaders to ensure the relevance of the organization into perpetuity.

Theta Beta Omega Chapter History

Located in New Bern, NC, Theta Beta Omega Chapter was established by Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Incorporated® in 1964 as its 198th graduate chapter. The chapter consisted of twenty ladies from New Bern, Robersonville-Williamston, and Beaufort areas with the heart and desire to embark on a program of service and involvement for their communities.

Today, the chapter is composed of women from diverse walks of life who are meeting the challenges of education, business, health, the arts, government and volunteerism. Its membership is involved in many programs, including scholarships, education, voter registration and education, health, and early cancer, prevention, detection, and support.

In 1956, Theta Beta Omega sponsored its first Debutante Ball and Cotillion which became the chapter's signature program. This activity has served not only as a fundraiser for scholarships and other community programs but has also provided educational and cultural enrichment activities for young women and men in the Tri-county area.

Tonight's event marks the 33rd Triennial Debutante Ball and Cotillion.





Norma Fisher Godette (1933 – 2023), a James City native and New Bern resident, was the last surviving Charter member of Theta Beta Omega Chapter of Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Incorporated®. Her involvement in Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Incorporated® began in 1954. A graduate of Winston-Salem State University, she continued her education earning a Master of Arts Degree in Education. Following her belief that "one could not learn enough be certified and qualified for now and the future," she completed further educational studies at Columbia University (New York City), Howard University (Washington, DC), and East Carolina University (Greenville). She was initiated into Gamma Lamba Chapter at WSSU. Mrs. Godette served Theta Beta Omega in various capacities: President, Vice President, Treasurer, and on various committees, both as a chairperson and a member. She is remembered for her passion for the creation and distribution of bookmarks to schools, libraries, and churches during African-American History Month.

Carthenia Clark Mann (1927 – 2022), a native of Pantego in Beaufort County, was initiated into Theta Beta Omega Chapter of Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Incorporated® and remained a lifelong member of the chapter. A graduate of NC Central University, she spent her working life as a public school teacher. Mrs. Mann held various positions in the chapter: President, Vice President, Recording and Corresponding Secretary, Assistant Recording Secretary, Chaplain, Sergeant-at-Arms, and Parliamentarian. She also served on a variety of chapter committees, including chairing By-Laws, 1970 Debutante Ball and Rituals. As part of her chapter work, she led Theta Beta Omega's first celebration under new Sorority guidelines that allowed chapters to design their own Founders' Day programs. Mrs. Mann is well-remembered for her words of support and wisdom.

Evelyn Celeste Skinner Simmons (1938 – 2023), a native of Elizabeth City, was educated and initiated into Delta Theta Chapter of Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Incorporated® at Elizabeth City State University, where she majored in English. She spent her career in the classroom, introducing young minds to the joys of literature and grammar. She was active in Theta Beta Omega Chapter, serving as President twice, Vice President, Secretary, Sergeant-at-Arms, and Parliamentarian. Her chapter work was wide-ranging. She was chairman, cochairman and member of Rituals, Health, History, Senior Residence, Standards, Music, Budget, Education, Black Family and others. Mrs. Simmons liked to have everything proper and in good order.

And above all, love yourself — deeply and unconditionally.


