## Oklahoma Dexter Cattle Association Exhibitor Year-end High Point Program

Starting January 1<sup>st</sup> through December 31<sup>st</sup>, 2025, members of the Oklahoma Dexter Cattle Association can compete with their animals for year-end high point awards. Points will be given for not only participation in Dexter shows but also any show that members competed in. (i.e., jackpots, county livestock show, and open cattle competitions).

This new program is intended to promote membership and friendly competition within the ODCA membership while displaying our dexter cattle at a local, state, and national level.

Divisions will include both Youth and Adult.

Breaks in the youth division:

Ages 7-11

Ages 12-14

Ages 15-19

Adults will all compete together but, in the future, it may include a '50 years old and Over division'.

Exhibitors may show as many cattle and go to as many competitions as they desire. Participation points will be given to all exhibitors with ADCA shows providing higher points than local all-breed competitions.

#### **ADCA** points

Attending ADCA competition – 5 points (for every show attended regardless of placings)

1st place – 10 points

2<sup>nd</sup> place - 9 points

3<sup>rd</sup> place - 8 points

4<sup>th</sup> place – 7 points

5<sup>th</sup> place – 6 points

6th place - 5 points

Division Champion 5 points

Grand Champion – 10 points

Reserve Grand Champion – 7 points

Best of Show - 15 points

# Open Show Points (i.e. Jackpots or all breed competitions)

Attending open show competition – 3 points (for every show regardless of placings)

1st place - 6 points

2<sup>nd</sup> place - 5 points

3<sup>rd</sup> place - 4 points

4th place - 3 points

5<sup>th</sup> place – 2 points

6<sup>th</sup> place –1 point

Breed Champion 5 points

Grand Champion – 10 points

Reserve Grand Champion - 7 points

Best of Show – 15 points

## **Award Qualifications**

- Exhibitors must have an ODCA membership to qualify for year-end awards.
- Exhibitors must attend at least <u>one</u> ADCA show in Oklahoma to qualify for awards (currently the Open Dexter show at the Tulsa State Fair).
- Exhibitors must have a current ODCA membership prior to earning any points.
- Exhibitors must submit a show affidavit for each show attended with their placings
  to assist with record keeping. Submit a photo with show backdrop, banner, or
  award as proof of attendance (may be a personal photo and doesn't have to be
  purchased from the show photographer). Forms need to be received by December
