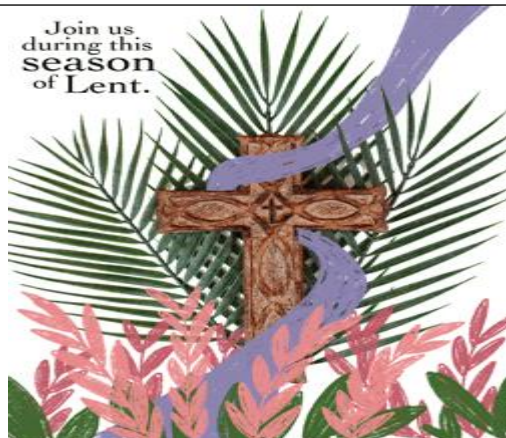

### Zachariah 9:9-10

#### The Coming of Zion's King

<sup>9</sup> Rejoice greatly, Daughter Zion!  
Shout, Daughter Jerusalem! See, your  
king comes to you, righteous and  
victorious, lowly and riding on a  
donkey, on a colt, the foal of a donkey.  
<sup>10</sup> I will take away the chariots from  
Ephraim and the warhorses from  
Jerusalem, and the battle bow will be  
broken. He will proclaim peace to the  
nations. His rule will extend from sea to  
sea and from the River to the ends of the  
earth.

### Revelation 19:11-16

#### The Heavenly Warrior Defeats the Beast

<sup>11</sup> I saw heaven standing open and there  
before me was a white horse, whose  
rider is called Faithful and True. With  
justice he judges and wages war. <sup>12</sup> His  
eyes are like blazing fire, and on his head  
are many crowns. He has a name written  
on him that no one knows but he

himself. <sup>13</sup> He is dressed in a robe dipped in blood, and his name is the Word of God. <sup>14</sup> The armies of heaven were following him, riding on white horses and dressed in fine linen, white and clean. <sup>15</sup> Coming out of his mouth is a sharp sword with which to strike down the nations. "He will rule them with an iron scepter."<sup>[a]</sup> He treads the winepress of the fury of the wrath of God Almighty. <sup>16</sup> On his robe and on his thigh he has this name written: King of kings and Lord of lords.

### **Gospel**

#### **Matthew 21:1-11**

#### **Jesus Comes to Jerusalem as King**

21 As they approached Jerusalem and came to Bethphage on the Mount of Olives, Jesus sent two disciples, <sup>2</sup> saying to them, "Go to the village ahead of you, and at once you will find a donkey tied there, with her colt by her. Untie them and bring them to me. <sup>3</sup> If anyone says anything to you, say that the Lord needs them, and he will send them right away."<sup>4</sup> This took place to fulfill what was spoken through the prophet: <sup>5</sup> "Say to Daughter Zion, 'See, your king comes to you, gentle and riding on a donkey, and on a colt, the foal of a donkey.'" <sup>6</sup> The disciples went and did as Jesus had instructed them. <sup>7</sup> They brought the donkey and the colt and placed their cloaks on them for Jesus to sit on. <sup>8</sup> A very large crowd spread their cloaks on the road, while others cut branches from the trees and spread them on the road. <sup>9</sup> The crowds that went ahead of him

and those that followed shouted, "Hosanna to the Son of David!" "Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord!" "Hosanna in the highest heaven!" <sup>10</sup> When Jesus entered Jerusalem, the whole city was stirred and asked, "Who is this?" <sup>11</sup> The crowds answered, "This is Jesus, the prophet from Nazareth in Galilee."
