### From the Desk of Pastor Bill

In the mid-1500s, English poet Thomas Tusser, wrote "Sweet April showers / Do spring May flowers". We have since simplified it to "April showers bring May flowers" For the most part, that is true. It is the warmer weather and rain of April that beings about the beauty of nature with tree blossoms and wildflowers we experience in May. It is a wonderful time of year. Everything is so beautiful, vibrant and alive in the Spring.

Our lives, as humans, are much like the seasons, always changing. During our younger years we are beautiful, vibrant and alive. As we get older, no matter how hard we try to stop it, our beauty and vibrancy fades. Consequently, the way we view life changes as well. We change. God, however, does not.

One of the characteristics of God agreed on by almost every theologian is that God is "immutable" meaning He is "unchanging over time or unable to be changed." God does not go through changes; He does not lose His vibrancy. He does not adapt to the different seasons of cultures...neither does His Word. The Apostle Peter, wanting to teach this truth to his readers, wrote this.

1 Peter 1:23-25

...you have been born again, not of perishable seed but of imperishable, through the living and abiding word of God; for

"All flesh is like grass

and all its glory like the flower of grass.

The grass withers,

and the flower falls,

but the word of the Lord remains forever."

And this word is the good news that was preached to you.

It's comforting for me to know that our salvation is not based on something that is going to change over time. As time moves on, God is not going to change His plan to better accommodate the thinking of the day. I am encouraged by Peter's words, "...the word of the Lord remains forever."
