## **SCRIPTURE READINGS**

### **Proverbs 1:1-9**

The proverbs of Solomon son of David, king of Israel: <sup>2</sup>for gaining wisdom and instruction; for understanding words of insight; <sup>3</sup>for receiving instruction in prudent behavior, doing what is right and just and fair; <sup>4</sup>for giving prudence to those who are simple, knowledge and discretion to the young—<sup>5</sup>let the wise listen and add to their learning, and let the discerning get guidance—

<sup>6</sup>for understanding proverbs and parables, the sayings and riddles of the wise.

<sup>7</sup>The fear of the LORD is the beginning of knowledge, but fools despise wisdom and instruction. <sup>8</sup>Listen, my son, to your father's instruction and do not forsake your mother's teaching. <sup>9</sup>They are a garland to grace your head and a chain to adorn your neck.

### **1 Thessalonians 2:6-10**

We were not looking for praise from people, not from you or anyone else, even though as apostles of Christ we could have asserted our authority. <sup>7</sup>Instead, we were like young children among you. Just as a nursing mother cares for her children, <sup>8</sup>so we cared for you. Because we loved you so much, we were delighted to share with you not only the gospel of God but our lives as well. <sup>9</sup>Surely you remember, brothers and sisters, our toil and hardship; we worked night and day in order not to be a burden to anyone while we preached the gospel of God to you. <sup>10</sup>You are witnesses, and so is God, of how holy, righteous and blameless we were among you who believed.

### **Gospel**

### **Mark 7:5-13**

<sup>5</sup>So the Pharisees and teachers of the law asked Jesus, "Why don't your disciples live according to the tradition of the elders instead of eating their food with defiled hands?" <sup>6</sup>He replied, "Isaiah was right when he prophesied about you hypocrites; as it is written:" "These people

honor me with their lips, but their hearts are far from me.<sup>7</sup> They worship me in vain; their teachings are merely human rules.’<sup>8</sup> You have let go of the commands of God and are holding on to human traditions.”<sup>9</sup> And he continued, “You have a fine way of setting aside the commands of God in order to observe your own traditions!”<sup>10</sup> For Moses said, ‘Honor your father and mother,’ and, ‘Anyone who curses their father or mother is to be put to death.’<sup>11</sup> But you say that if anyone declares that what might have been used to help their father or mother is Corban (that is, devoted to God)—<sup>12</sup> then you no longer let them do anything for their father or mother.<sup>13</sup> Thus you nullify the word of God by your tradition that you have handed down. And you do many things like that.”
