From the Desk of Pastor Bill

Here's a question..."What do June bugs and Asparagus have in common? I'm sure that there are many answers to that, but for my purpose I would answer that, "They both have a relatively short existence." At least in what we can see. We start to see June bugs in late May hovering around our porch lights (and crunching underfoot) and by the end of June, they seem to no longer be a problem. As for Asparagus...the harvest season of only about a month, seems way too short for people like me who love fresh asparagus. From what we can see, both of these things are short lived.

If we do a little research though, we find that both of these things have a lot longer life than we know. It turns out that a June bug actually "lives" for up to 3 years in its various stages and an Asparagus plant can continue to produce for 15 to 20 years.

We, as people, are much the same. In James 4:14 it says, "What is your life? You are a mist that appears for a little while and then vanishes." Our lives, especially the productive years, can seem so short. Like the June bug and the asparagus plant, that is only what we see. In truth, our existence is eternal. Perhaps that is why God encourages us in 2 Corinthians 4:17 to..." fix our eyes not on what is seen, but on what is unseen, since what is seen is temporary, but what is unseen is eternal."

There is far more to our existence than meets the eye. As God's children thought faith in Christ, we are going to live forever. In light of eternity this life is little more than a mist. Our response to that truth should change our focus. In Colossians 3:1,2 the Apostle Paul writes, "Since, then, you have been raised with Christ, set your hearts on things above, where Christ is, seated at the right hand of God. 2 Set your minds on things above, not on earthly things.

As you sweep the June bugs off your porch be reminded that just like them there is much more to your existence than just this life...In Christ, there is so much more!
