From the Desk of Pastor Bill

On July 4th, we celebrate Independence Day. It is the day we remember the founders of our country fighting to free themselves, and ultimately us, from the rule and reign of England. Mankind has always sought to be free. The greatest freedoms we have, though, are not those purchased for us by the early patriots but those talked about in John 8:31,32

"So Jesus said to the Jews who had believed him, "If you abide in my word, you are truly my disciples, and you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free."

According to Jesus, there is freedom in knowing the truths revealed in God's holy Word. What are those freedoms? According to some Bible scholars there are as many as 16 different freedoms we gain when we choose to follow Christ. Here are 8 of the 16.

- 1. Freedom from guilt. "There is therefore now no condemnation to those who are in Christ Jesus" (Rom. 8:1).
- 2. Freedom from shame. "Whoever believes on Him will not be put to shame" (Rom. 10:11).
- 3. Freedom from God's wrath "For God did not appoint us to wrath, but to obtain salvation through our Lord Jesus Christ" (1 Thess. 5:9).
- 4. Freedom from fear of death. "But has now been revealed by the appearing of our Savior Jesus Christ, who has abolished death and brought life and immortality to light through the gospel" (2 Tim. 1:10).

- 5. Freedom from bondage to sin. "For sin shall not have dominion over you, for you are not under law but under grace" (Rom. 6:14).
- 6. Freedom from Satan's dominion. "He has delivered us from the power of darkness and conveyed us into the kingdom of the Son of His love" (Col. 1:13).
- 7. Freedom to approach God. "Therefore, brethren, having boldness to enter the Holiest by the blood of Jesus" (Heb. 10:19).
- 8. Freedom to enter the gates of heaven. "In My Father's house are many mansions; if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you. And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and receive you to Myself; that where I am, there you may be also" (John 14:2–3).

Council to search and recommend 2 congregation members for Nominating Committee. Jessie Glodowski willing to serve as council member. Need 3 members- 2 congregation and 1 council.

Pam and Jessie have updated physical mailing addresses, and will work with Dianne E to update email and text lists of members.

Pork Extravaganza flyers printed and members encouraged to hang them in public places.

Robbie Lashua will continue researching parking lot project.

The plan for a hand rail up to the altar was discussed. Larry had measured and came up with ideas. Concern was any fixtures could become a trip hazard. It was expressed that in previous years, 1 of the 2 ushers would post up at the front to assist an arm to anyone for the step up. This will be communicated to the head usher and team.

Treasurer's report: accepted without objection 5/31/2025 Checking Balance \$42,091.71 5/31/2025 Savings Balance \$150,391.91 Cash Flow for May 2025 \$4,883.98

Pastor's Report- New members recommended to the council: Nick & Brooke Patrick, Elizabeth (Beth) Schmude, Erin Lashua. Motion to accept these as new members made by Robbie L. Second made by Larry B. Motion carried. Pastor also visited Doug Thompson multiple times both in Waupaca and Appleton.

Pastor Bill worked on the lighted sign out roadside. After taking it apart and researching quotes, one option was approximately \$900, and a second option was about \$300, with each doing different repairs. Council discussed the \$300 option would make the most sense. Robbie L made a motion to move ahead with the \$300 repair option, second by Pam D. Motion carried.

Two nominations for Council Nominating Committee were made, Jessie Glodowski as council member, and Dianne Erickson as congregation member. Still working on filling the 3rd open position. Motion to elect Jessie and Dianne to Nominating Committee made by Robbie L, second by Larry B. Motion carried.

Pork Extravaganza planning going well.

Total received from logging the church property is \$16,581.99. Council will review the contract for verification of compliance with the quote.

Richard K thanked those that worked with Harmann Studios, as they were no longer suiting the needs of our congregation leading to cancellation.

Robbie L is working on mapping the parking lot.

Larry B updated council on Lori B's work on an Usher Training manual. Waiting for review and feedback from head usher Dale Thompson before being sent to council and congregation.
