From the Desk of Pastor Bill

Each month, I like to write about something unique about that month. Of Course, December is all about Christmas. One of the things I always look forward to during the Christmas season is the kids' program at church. I love the sets. I love the costumes. I love the songs, and I love, once again, hearing the old, old story of the coming of our Savior, Jesus Christ.

There's one character who usually does not make it into the kid's program that I especially like. It's the old man Simeon. In the second chapter of the gospel of Luke we read,

"At that time there was a man in Jerusalem named Simeon. He was righteous and devout and was eagerly waiting for the Messiah to come and rescue Israel. The Holy Spirit was upon him and had revealed to him that he would not die until he had seen the Lord's Messiah. That day the Spirit led him to the Temple. So when Mary and Joseph came to present the baby Jesus to the Lord as the law required, Simeon was there. He took the child in his arms and praised God, saying,

"Sovereign Lord, now let your servant die in peace, as you have promised. I have seen your salvation, which you have prepared for all people."

Simeons life and words sum up the Gospel message so well. He was waiting for God's salvation and now that he had seen the promised Savior, Jesus, He was ready to die in peace.

The true message of the Christmas story is not about Mary or Joseph. It's not about shepherds or angels. It's not about wise men or a bright star. It's not about an Inn with no room or even a manger. It's about God's promised Messiah (Savior) coming to earth and the importance of us looking to Him for our Salvation. Like Simeon, we too can face eternity in peace if, in faith, we look to Jesus, the Savior born on that day.

We will continue to investigate replacing Orangeburg septic pipe that is suspected to be a source of contamination. Another possible contamination source could be a neighboring retired landfill.

Janitor has requested a salary increase to \$3,300.00. Jessie G made a motion to keep the budget at current amount until annual paid employee's performance reviews are completed. Larry B second. Motion carried.

Council moved into 2026 Budget discussion. Treasurer Daniele will send updated budget to council to present at the annual meeting.
