THE HOMELESS CRISES

Black Americans experience homelessness at higher rates than Whites, largely due to long-standing historical and structural racism. The Homeless crisis is a complex problem in every city across America but especially for Descendants of American slaves who are traditionally marginalized. Over a million people experienced homelessness in 2024 and the number of unsheltered individuals increases all the time and is still getting worse. Everyone agrees that to *end-homelessness*, we must actually provide, housing. There are plenty of shelters to accommodate households and individuals who are experiencing brief short-term homelessness, but there is no housing for unsheltered individuals that need long term assistance.

The Housing Village expands the current number of available housing to provide for a greater number of unsheltered individuals. The Housing Village can affectively house over 1,500 homeless individuals, on 50 acres of land in a rural community village setting. We supply housing, food stability and healing programs to homeless individuals.

DOWNTOWN BUSINESS CORRIDORS HOMELESS CRISIS



Grand Rapids businesses have reported that there is an ongoing problem caused by homeless people laying in business doorways, aggressive panhandlers harassing customers outside of businesses, street fights and public urination. These problems also occur in other business corridors including Monroe Center, Louis Campau Promenade, and Bridge Street. Ordinances were created to promote downtown safety for the business community but this band aid has done little to resolve real problem of the need for housing for the homeless. An estimated 1,239 unhoused residents still congregate downtown. We offer the city of Grand Rapids a Rural Village as the answer to stopping the ravishes of homeless activities in the downtown businesses corridors. The village will comfortably house the homeless population away from downtown businesses.

CITY HOMELESS SOLUTIONS FAILED



Grand Rapids Solution to Homelessness has Failed. City shuts down Heartside Park tent city. The number of individuals considered “unsheltered” has increased, according to an annual survey conducted in January 2022, by the Grand Rapids Area Coalition to End Homelessness. The survey found that since 2018, the homeless population in Grand Rapids has nearly doubled, from 723 in January 2018 to 1,239 in January 2023. And because there is no dependable long term housing available, most individuals live in shelters, transitional housing and on the streets.
