**DEVOTIONAL:** The devotion was given by Linda Perry. “Who was Nicodemus” Nicodemus, which means “conqueror of the people” was a Pharisee, a ruler of the Jews, and a teacher of Israel. His secret visit to our Lord, led to significant discourse recorded only by St John. Nicodemus showed noble candor and simple love of truth despite his hesitation and fear of man. Ultimately, he became a follower of Christ and together with Joseph of Arimathea, took down and embalmed the body of Jesus.
