What Is the Law on Age Requirements with Golf Carts?

A law recently took effect in Florida that changes the age of individuals who can drive golf carts.

Teens can only drive a golf cart if they hold a driver's license or permit. Previously, teens as young as 14 years old were permitted to drive golf carts. At the same time, younger children got away with operating the vehicles.

The new law affects the entire state, making it challenging for local governments to modify the age requirement.

Now, **teens must be at least 15 and hold a learner's permit or 16 and hold a driver's license.** Individuals 18 and over need a valid ID issued by the government to operate a golf cart. Let's all be safe!



Procedure for MFL Missed Trash Pick up & Bulk Pickup.

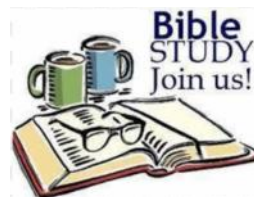

Pool Rules



For the safety of yourself and all residents, please observe and follow the pool rules that are posted. Loud music and vulgar language will not be tolerated, please be respectful of others. There are designated NO SMOKING areas, please use the ash trays. *Remember use of marijuana is illegal, and medical marijuana can only be used in private places.* If you move any furniture, please return it back

to its original spot. NO glass containers of any kind are allowed in or around pool at any time. No food or drinks except for water are allowed within 4 feet of the pool, and no animals are allowed.

Diving, splashing, ball throwing, screaming, running, disruptive or dangerous behavior, horseplay, and loud noises are not permitted. It is imperative to dry off before you enter the clubhouse and restrooms. Wet bathing suits can cause floors to be slippery, which can cause falls. Cover-ups, shirts, and shoes are mandatory inside the clubhouse at all times. **Please** roll down the umbrellas on the tables after each use and put back any pool furniture that you move. Your cooperation is greatly appreciated, please remember you are responsible for your guests' behavior. *Irrigation is prohibited between 10am and 4 pm

*Residential irrigation at **odd numbered** addresses or no addresses is allowed
Wednesday & Saturday.

*Residential irrigation at **even numbered** addresses is allowed on **Thursday & Sunday.**

*Irrigation is limited to no more that 3/4 inch of water and/or to no more than one hour per zone per irrigation day.

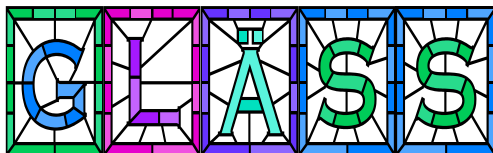
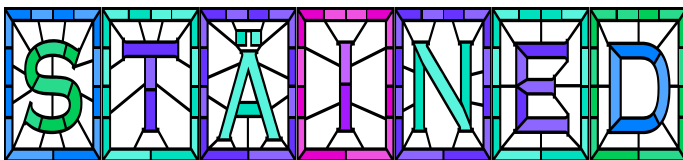

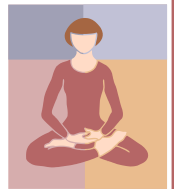
