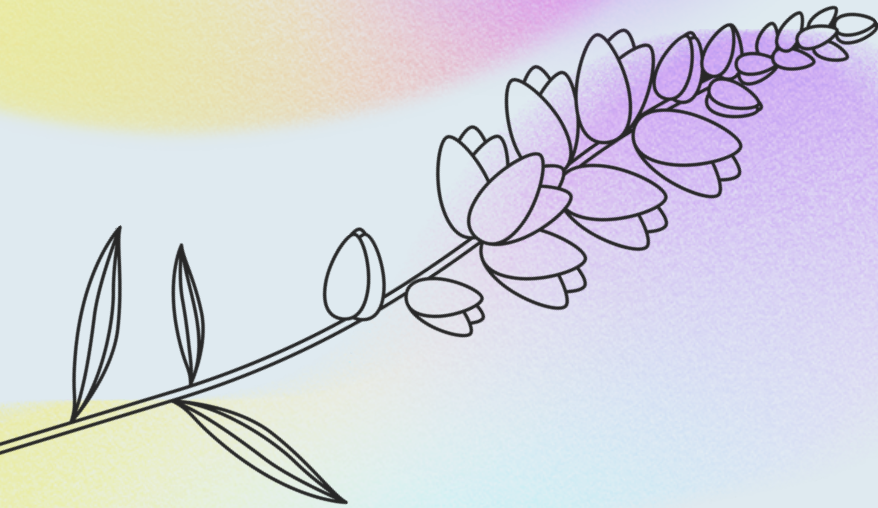

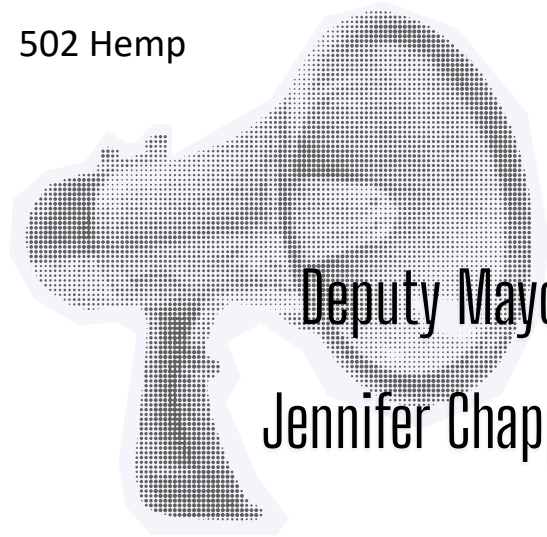

The Louisville Historical League, in association with Councilwoman Jennifer Chappell, is seeking to save the historic Kentucky Wagon building, which is located near Eastern Parkway and Third Street. Kentucky Wagon was a world-wide horse-drawn wagon and carriage manufacturer in the late 1800s and early 1900s. It employed hundreds of Louisvillians. (It still exists but is now known as Kentucky Trailer and located in the southwest Riverport.) A landmarks petition is being prepared to protect this last remaining structure of this legendary Louisville business.
