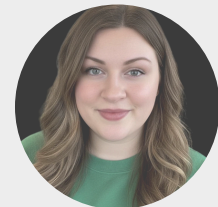

“LOUISVILLE, Ky. (WAVE)- A Louisville lawmaker is looking for ways to expand Dolly Parton’s Imagination Library across the entire commonwealth.

The program provides free age-appropriate books to children from birth to five years old.

Tuesday in Frankfort, a Senate Committee approved Joint Resolution 54, which looks to expand the immigration library. Louisville Democrat Cassie Chamber Armstrong sponsored the measure.

It directs the Department for Library and Archives and the Cabinet for Health and Family Services to work on increasing participation in the program.

During Tuesday’s Senate hearing, educators shared the importance of early literacy in the commonwealth.

‘We’ve got to be building strong leaders today and as many of them as possible. In my local program in Russell County, 93% of all children under the age of five are enrolled in Imagination Library, and with that level of saturation, we expect to see major gains in reading scores, which translates to graduation, which translates to employment and success in life,’ administrative agent for Dolly Parton’s Imagination Library Lindsey Westerfield said.

Joint Resolution 54 now moves to the full Senate for consideration.
