

Original Bennett, HCMI and newer version Bennett

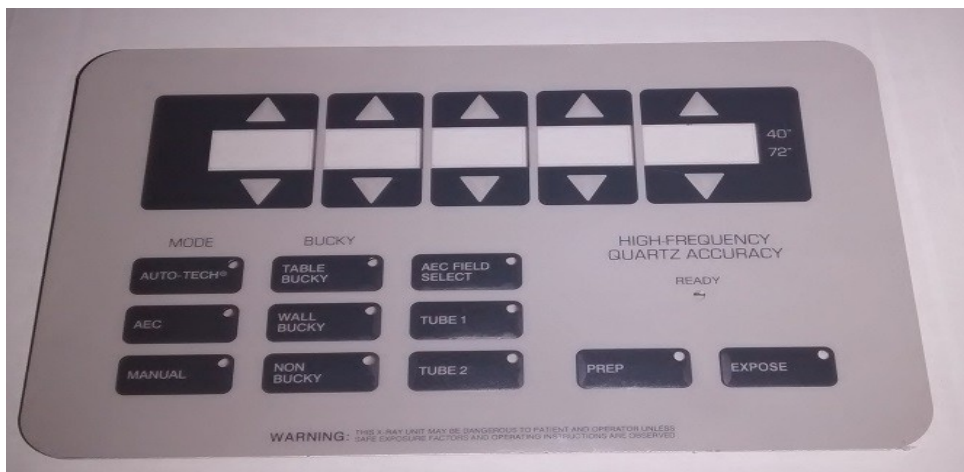
It can get confusing without a doubt. One or two easy ways to tell is an original Bennett console has a key switch in the back and the corners of the switch panel are rounded.

The HCMI or what was later renamed Bennett does not have a key switch in the back and the corners of it's switch panel are square. That's the two easiest ways to tell.

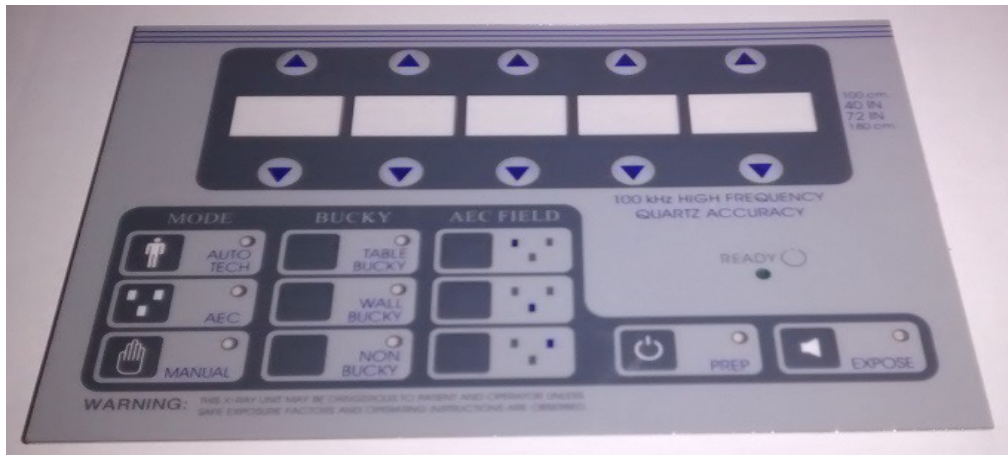
This is the back of an original Bennett console. Notice the key switch.



This is a original Bennett switch panel. The corners are round. Original part# 101671 (switch panel only). The complete Bennett console is a part# 10125



This is an HCMI switch panel and later took on the Bennett name.



It has square corners. We use a part# SW-0045 (switch panel only)

Complete console, Part# SW-CON-HCMI

Hopefully this clears up some of the confusion.
