Coronavirus (Covid-19) is dominating the news at the moment, and so our Leadership Team met this afternoon to discuss how we as a church should respond. It is an ever changing picture, but here is what we have decided for now:

Until or unless the Government guidance changes, **Sunday Services will continue as normal** and we look forward to seeing you. However, if you are not feeling well (temperature or cough) then please stay at home and self-isolate.

Of course we do need to take a few sensible precautions and make a few changes in the light of the Coronavirus, so here are a few things to bear in mind:

Sunday Services

- 1. An anti-bacterial hand sanitiser will be available at the front door please use it when you first come in.
- 2. Please avoid direct physical contact this means no hugs and handshakes for the time being.
- 3. Please wash your hands as regularly as practical.
- 4. "Catch it, Bin it, Kill it" is the current mantra, so please use tissues or your inside elbow for coughs and sneezes.
- 5. The cafe will be shut during this epidemic. There will be no teas or coffees, so if you need a drink please bring bottled water.
- 6. There will be no Breaking of Bread during the service. We encourage families to break bread together at home instead.

Other Events

- 1. There will be no Wednesday **Evergreen** lunch until further notice.
- 2. Other activities will be constantly reviewed, but for the time being are still running.
