Some of the people we hope to help are finding that financially they are struggling badly in this crisis – perhaps because their income has been cut drastically, or they have lost their job altogether as a result of the stringent measures being implemented. It is going to cost money to support these people with food and other essentials. Therefore, as a Church, we would like to open a 'Coronavirus Response' fund that can be used to direct resources to those most in need.
