CHECK IN PROTOCOL: see map

For Track Events

1. Check in at tent at the 50 yard line
2. Find name, heat and lane/position on heat sheet.
3. Get your hip numbers (one on left chest, one on left hip)
4. Complete warm-up on practice turf field next to stadium
5. Show up to the start line at least 15 minutes (or 1 event) before your race
6. The line clerk will check you in and put you in your heat/lane

For Field Events

1. Check in **at event with official at least 30 minutes before start time** (no numbers required)

AWARDS: first place, all 4 relay members

FACILITY: Concessions stand, newly-renovated indoor bathrooms, stadium seating, meet announcer and music, live results, warm-up field next to stadium, Little Dry Creek Path for warm-up/cool-down

STARTING HEIGHTS/FIELD EVENTS:

Marks will be geared towards qualifying for state- High Jump will start at 4-6 inches below current state qualifying marks on MaxPreps and there will be a “no-mark” line in throws and horizontal jumps if not reasonably close to a state qualifying marks. Final distances will be determined after entries close. **All throws and horizontal jumps will be 3 throws + Finals.**

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- **Admission:** Tickets will be \$5 at the gate, for each session
- Tents may only be set up on the top row of bleachers, first come first serve.
- Concessions will be available throughout both days of the meet
- A trainer and training room will be available for treatment of injuries.
