



2020 EMBRYO TRANSFER CONTRACT

This contract for Embryo Transfer ("*Agreement*") is made this _____ day of _____, 2020, between Shoreline Equine Veterinary Services, and _____ ("*Mare Owner*"). This agreement certifies that Shoreline Equine Veterinary Services agrees to attempt removal of embryos from _____ ("*donor mare*") Registration # _____

This procedure will be a non-surgical technique. An embryo considered viable by Shoreline Equine Veterinary Services will be transferred into the reproductive tract of an appropriate "recipient mare." The Mare Owner and Shoreline Equine Veterinary Services agree to the following:

1. Embryo Transfer Fees

Embryo flush	\$350.00 per attempt
Embryo transfer	\$400.00 when viable embryo is recovered
Pregnant recipient at 15 days	\$2000 due
Pregnant recipient at 45 days	\$1500 due at release

2. Mare Owner will be charged mare care at the board rate of \$30 per day while their donor mare is residing at Ted Robinson Training Stable. Mare Owner will be responsible for paying all veterinary fees associated with the routine and reproductive care of the donor mare. It is understood and agreed by Mare Owner that Shoreline Equine Veterinary Services will not be responsible for accident, sickness or death of the donor mare or her offspring. Shoreline Equine Veterinary Services will exercise judgment in the care and supervision of said mare and her offspring.

3. Upon confirmation of a 15-day pregnancy in the recipient mare that has received the embryo from the donor mare, Mare Owner agrees to pay \$2,000. Upon confirmation of a 45-day pregnancy, Mare Owner agrees to pay the balance due of \$1500. Shoreline Equine Veterinary Services agrees to provide recipient mare and pay all expenses associated with maintaining said recipient mare until a 45-day pregnancy has been established. Once a 45day pregnancy has been confirmed, the mare owner shall pick up the recipient mare or agrees to pay mare care to Ted Robinson Training Stable at a rate of \$30 per day until able to do so.

4. It is the Mare Owner's responsibility to board and care for the recipient mare during gestation and subsequent nursing of the resulting foal. It is understood that Shoreline Equine Veterinary Services or affiliate retains ownership of recipient mare. A \$1500 replacement fee will be assessed to the Mare Owner if she is not returned in a timely manner. It is further agreed that should Mare Owner elect to pick up recipient mare, all liability for said recipient mare will be that of the Mare Owner during the time period that they have possession of said recipient mare.



5. If the donor mare is bred three complete cycles with three embryo recovery attempts and a viable embryo has not been obtained, the Mare Owner will be contacted by Shoreline Equine Veterinary Services to discuss further attempts at embryo retrieval.

6. It shall be the Mare Owner's responsibility to notify breed registries and fulfill registry requirements for embryo transfer.

7. This contract does not constitute a live foal guarantee. Shoreline Equine Veterinary Services assumes no responsibility for the pregnancy after 45 days. Live foal insurance can be obtained from most equine insurance companies and is the sole responsibility of the Mare Owner.

8. The Mare Owner agrees to pay all charges in full before removing the pregnant recipient mare from Ted Robinson Training Stable unless prior arrangements have been approved. Mare Owner agrees to pay all fees for services within 10 days of billing. Any past due account which is not paid within thirty days of billing shall be subject to collection action, including placing the account in the hands of an attorney for collection. Mare Owner assumes and agrees to pay all costs of collection, including charges, expenses, attorney fees and related costs which shall be incurred in the collection of this account.
