I. Preliminary remarks

On January 31st, 1945 there was a loss with the *Wilhelm Gustloff*. Under this heading, the departments of the German Red Cross, and other search services including the German service for the notification of family members of the German Wehrmacht, registered names, facts of missing, dead, and survivors of the sinking of the *M/S Wilhelm Gustloff* on January 30th, 1945 in the Baltic Sea.

In the post-war period, numbers of people who embarked on the last trip of the *M/S Wilhelm Gustloff*, the ships involved in the rescue operation, as well as figures of deaths and deaths, were published in German and foreign newspapers, magazines, and books, radio and television. Survivors of the disaster night can be inaccurate, understated or exaggerated. In a few months after the end of the Second World War, I began to collect all the documents which could be obtained about the *Gustloff* catastrophe and its connections in my Gustloff Archives. Included in this task from the outset was the identification of concrete facts about the number of people who embarked on the last journey: passengers, the missing and the dead as well as the survivors.

I needed 39 years for this comprehensive investigation. The following task was to be accomplished:

1. Contact with all search services and services dealing with the loss of *M/S Wilhelm Gustloff*, including the transparency and evaluation of the documents available at these search services and services.
2. Determination of all ships of the naval and naval armies and of the Luftwaffe, who participated in the rescue of *Gustloff* on the night of January 30th. Identification of

the addresses of the commanders, captains and deck officers of these vessels for the purpose of the survey are also included.

3. The questioning of commanders, captains, officers and ascertained crew members of all rescue vessels by means of personal visits, interviews, telephone calls, letters and special questionnaires, evaluation of these statements and reports.

4. Purchasing the originals or copies of the lists and lists of saved, dead and missing persons, as well as those who were in the archives, obtaining the partly preserved list of embarkations of the *M/S Wilhelm Gustloff* of the last journey on January 30th, 1945.

5. Survey of all the survivors of the *Gustloff* catastrophe, whose names and addresses were known to me to learn more addresses survivors.

6. Procurement of the opinions of military bodies on the sinking of the *M/S Wilhelm Gustloff* and its connections, in particular the opinion of the surviving commander of the 2nd division of the U.L.D., Gotenhafen-Oxhöft, Korvettenkapitän Wilhelm Zahn.

It was only through this intensive, comprehensive, targeted investigation and the screening of the existing archive material of state and private archives and collections that I was able to gain more comprehensive knowledge of the *Gustloff* catastrophe, its connections and more concrete figures and facts of the embarked, missing and surviving persons of the sinking of the *M/S Wilhelm Gustloff*.

II. Report of the Commander of the 2nd Division U.L.D., on the sinking of the M/S Wilhelm Gustloff on January 30th, 1945:

After the sinking of *M/S Wilhelm Gustloff*, a whole series of important questions have been asked and discussed in the circle of the survivors, maritime departments, the members of *Gustloff* victims and those interested in the history. E.g. The question of why the *Gustloff* left Gotenhafen-Oxhoft without sufficient escort, why the coastal route was not chosen, why on zig-zag course and maximum speed was not run on the Emergency Route 58, and whether a larger number of shipwrecked passengers could have been saved.

On these and other questions, Corvette Captain Wilhelm Zahn, Commander of the 2nd Division U.L.D., who witnessed the ship's sinking, a few days after the disaster on February 4th, 1945, he sent a written report to the Naval Command in the East to the Commander-in-Chief of the Kriegsmarine. - Appendix 1 to the documentation –

III. People posted as on board the M/S Wilhelm Gustloff, January 30th, 1945:

On January 30th, 1945, after the taking on of the last refugees by the steamship *Ravel*, arriving from Pillau, the following were on board the *M/S Wilhelm Gustloff*.

- 4,974 refugees from East Prussia, from the Memelland, and from West Prussia, mainly from the Elbing, Gotenhafen, Gdansk and Sopot regions.

- 918 Officers, unofficial officers, and men of the 2.UL Division, Gotenhafen-Oxhoft.

- 173 Crew members of the merchant navies.

- 162 Wounded.
- 373 Women's Naval Auxiliary members of the 2. U.L.D. and units of the submarine division, as well as the M.H. Readiness of the Wehrmacht Commander Gotenhafen, the Navigation School Gotenhafen, the Navy Flak Division 219, the Navy Flak Division 249, the Navy Flak Division 259 and a few assistants of other units.

The total number of 6,600 passengers on board during the accident night is not an absolute number, but it seems very realistic. It may be that during the last embarkation hours, some refugees could not be included in the embarkation list or were not recorded in figures, but their number would hardly have exceeded 100. The often-published number of 904 survivors, according to the investigations carried out by me up to December 31st, 1950, is no longer true; More than 1,200 shipwrecked people were saved. Also on the structure of the on board passengers, the composition of the 6,600 passengers arranged by gender, is now available:

Assuming that among the refugees who were on the *Gustloff* there were only very few men, and even very few isolated women, but mainly mothers with two or more children, the naval helpers and the female civilian occupiers are considered in the following picture:

Of the 6,600 persons on board there were:

1,300 men and women.

5,300 women and children.

Among the 5,300 women and children, the number of children was approximately 3,100. This gives the following overview of the groups of persons on board:

1,300 men.

2,200 women, mostly mothers.

3,100 children from the infants to the age of 16.

The partially preserved embarkation list of the *M/S Wilhelm Gustloff*, which is located in the Gustloff-Archiv (partly in original, partly in Fotokopie), contains in part I letter A-M 1,704 names, in part II - letters N-Z 2,665 names, a total of 4,369 names of refugees. The names of the officers, subordinates, and men of the 2 U.L.D., crew members of merchant marines, naval helpers, and wounded on board are not included in these embarkation lists.

IV. Ships of the Martial and Commercial Marines involved in the rescue of the *Wilhelm Gustloff*.

Evidently, the following ships of the war and merchant marine were involved in the rescue of *Wilhelm Gustloff*:

1. The escort leader of the *M/S Wilhelm Gustloff* on the last trip, the torpedo-boat *Löwe* under the command of Captain-Lieutenant Paul Prüfe.
2. With the heavy cruiser *Admiral Hipper*, the accompanying boat, the torpedo-flotilla boat *T-36* under the leadership of Captain Robert Hering.

3. The merchant steamship, *Göttingen*, under the leadership of the merchant shipbuilder Friedrich Segelken,
4. The Minuchsuehboot *M387 / TS II* accompanying the steamship under the leadership of Oberleutnant Karl Brinkmann.
5. The Minensuehboot *M375 / TS8* also accompanying the steamship, under the leadership of Oberleutnant Walter Weichel.
6. The torpedo boat *TF19* belonging to the escort, under the leadership of Oberleutnant Walter Schick.
7. The merchant steamship, *Gotenland* under the leadership of merchant merchant Captain Heinz Vollmers.
8. The Minnesuehboot *M341* accompanying the steamer *Gotenland*; under the leadership of Lieutenant Henry Rickmers.
9. The outpost boat *Vp1703*, which had been emptied out of *Gotenland*, under the leadership of Captain Helmut Hanefeld.

These nine ships saved a total of 1,252 shipwrecked ships from the *M/S Wilhelm Gustloff*. - Appendix 2 of the documentation. -

Post-war publications have proved to be completely inaccurate, according to which a freighter *Brigitte Leonhard* was involved in the rescue of *Gustloff* ship and saved 38 survivors. A freighter *Brigitte Leonhard* has never existed. Other Leonhard ships were not in the sea area during the night of the sinking and therefore could have been part of the rescue. This has been shown by careful research. Similarly, the participation of a steamer named *Sachsenwald*, which, according to publications, has not been used in a rescue of the *M/S Wilhelm Gustloff*, proved to be inaccurate and untenable. The HAL steamer *Sachsenwald*, 4,561 BRT, built in 1910, was already scrapped in Genoa in 1931. The steamer *Sachsenwald*, built in 1944-45 on the Flender shipyard, was only delivered in March 1945 and then deployed in the Baltic Sea for refugee transports. Her crew could not have been involved in the rescue based from the date of delivery of this ship. Both the *T36* and *Löwe* recovered *Gustloff* survivors which were recorded in their lists. These documents, however, have been lost through the effects of war. The same applies to almost all other cruise ships, with the following exceptions:

VI. Dead

M/S Wilhelm Gustloff, lost persons lists by the dead do not exist, except one exception: a list of dead members of the Kriegsmarine (2nd U.L.D.) who could be identified and confirmed, no written reports and documents.

The memorandum of the funeral of 143 persons on February 2nd, 1945, in Pillau, Cemetery I, is available on the burial of the dead of the *M/S Wilhelm Gustloff*.

Regarding deaths on the occasion of the sinking of the *M/S Wilhelm Gustloff* there is a reference, compiled by the registry office I Berlin, Berlin-Dahlem, Lentzeallee 107M from the death book of the registry office Gotenhafen, 1945.

There were records and records of the *Gustloff*-dead buried in Gotenhafen, as was the case in the past in Swinemünde, Kolberg, and Saßnitz. Since the sinking of the *M/S Wilhelm Gustloff*, a large number of missing have been declared dead. For the declaration of death, the district court of Hamburg, Division 54, is responsible as the home port of the *M/S Wilhelm Gustloff*, according to 1 of the Verschollengesetzes.

VII. Surviving

On the basis of the reports to the services of the Kriegsmarine, the documents of the Hamburg-South American steamship company of Hamburg, the *Gustloff*, the German Red Cross and other search services, the Deutsche Dienststelle in Berlin, and not

least the Gustloff Archives The superintendent of the sinking of *M/S Wilhelm Gustloff* on January 30th, 1945, which, however, can not claim to be exhaustive search. A considerable part of the *Gustloff* survivors live in the GDR and abroad and could not be determined despite careful research. Nevertheless, about half the names of all survivors have been identified and included in the list.

VIII. Conclusions:

The figures and facts about the number of passengers on the last trip of the *Gustloff*, the missing ones, the survivors and the dead, do not raise the claim to absolute completeness and correctness, but are very close to the actual figures; In any case, they reflect the current state of my 39 years of research, correct the wrong information, and also answer a few questions raised in the public. However, some questions cannot be answered definitively, and answers to them would not be provable.

For example, the question complex is difficult to answer:

- How many of the 6,600 persons who were on board the *Wilhelm Gustloff* during the disaster night are crowded on the free upper deck of the ship and then thrown into the sea and;
- How many died under the deck by the torpedo explosions, in the aisles, cabins and in the Lower Promenade Deck?

In answering these questions, I am dependent on estimates which I will try, from my knowledge of the subject, after a thorough study of all the documents and consideration of all factors. According to my cautious estimates, the following figures are realistic:

- About a thousand people died of torpedo explosions, around the mounds of luggage in the chambers, in the crowds in the stairs, or they were so severely injured that they could not get to the upper decks without the aid of others, and went down with the ship.
- About a thousand people, who were waiting in the lower deck of the promenades for the arrival of rescue ships and were surprised by the floods of the port side, found death in this closed deck.
- About a thousand and one hundred people were still aboard the ship when it was sinking completely into the waters of the Baltic Sea. This group of people probably existed almost exclusively from mothers with children. Since the outposts for the *Gustloff* in Gotenhafen only chose mothers with two or more small children for the journey with the *Gustloff*, the number of embarked children was unusually large. Most mothers were afraid to put the children in boats and rafts, to resign themselves, or to separate from one or the other child. Many women were so confused by panicky moods that they ran with their children back and forth, sought lost children, and refused to jump into the water, even after begging and asking the naval members.

- About three thousand of a total of six and a half thousand men can have entered the Baltic Sea, perhaps some more or less. The fact that relatively few shipwrecked people were buried dead, and that they were not washed ashore, is also less probable. About three thousand people fell into the Baltic Sea. Only the salvage of about 300 *Gustloff* dead was known.

On the basis of the figures, the documents and the reports, I find the following remark particularly remarkable: most of the victims of the *Gustloff* catastrophe were children!

This is due to the following facts:

Of the 918 officers, sub-officers, and men of the 2.U.L.D., who were on board, 390 were reported as missing. Thus, 528 soldiers have survived.

- Of the 173 civilian crew members are reported as missing by the shipping company 90. Thus, 83 have survived.

Of the military and civilian occupiers - a total of 1,091 - have survived - according to these concrete figures - 611, thus representing almost exactly half of all survivors. This is undoubtedly due to the fact that these were mostly shipyards, for the most part young men, who had been on board for a long time, who learned their way around the *Gustloff* from head to toe, and survived the disaster relatively easily, both mentally and physically. Children, also drifting in the water, these men had the greater survival chances.

Of the total of 373 maritime aid women, 250 were reported missing. 123 have survived the disaster. Here, too, we were dealing with younger people, girls, and women.

- Of the 4,974 women on board, mostly mothers with two or more children and the 162 heavy wounded (5,136 persons in total), only 518 survived, mainly women.

It must be assumed that of the approximately 3,100 children on board, less than a hundred survived, and about 3,000 children died in the fall of the *M/S Wilhelm Gustloff*.

In the night of January 30th, 1945, the tragedy of the sinking of the former KdF ship, *Wilhelm Gustloff*, was brought to light in a new light by the fact that this documentary became known for the first time in forty years after the catastrophe. Law in the case of shipwrecks in the Christian seafaring tradition is first the rescue of women and children, but this was reversed in the *Gustloff* catastrophe; Here women and children died first. But it was not a misfortune of a ship, but the conscious destruction of innocent women and children in the final phase of a murderous war, which ended here in such a tragic and shocking manner, with the greatest sacrifices for children and women. They died agonizingly during the *Gustloff* catastrophe in a sinking, death-hit ship, or in an ice-cold stormy winter night in the Baltic Sea.

The torpedoing of the *Wilhelm Gustloff*, by the Soviet submarine S-13, did not affect the elite soldiers of the German submarine units and several thousand Hitlerists, as manifested several times in Soviet post-war releases, but killed 3,000 children and nearly 2,000 women. This is the moral guilt of the Soviet submarine commander, Alexander Marinesko, who gave orders to fire three torpedoes on the refugee ship *Wilhelm Gustloff*, which he considered to be a large troop carrier and thus conjured up the greatest ship disaster of the Second World War, which had no glory and heroism of the Soviet submarine fleet, and which will remain unforgotten for all time as a tragedy of a refugee ship - Heinz Schön

Attachment 1

Report of Corvette Captain Zahn. On the 30th of January, 1945, the *M/S Wilhelm Gustloff* sailed for Kiel. On February 4th, 1945, a report was made to the naval commander-in-chief for the transfer to the naval commander of the navy.

I. General Information

1. *W.G.* was quiet for about 5 years in Gotenhafen. The seafarers were largely withdrawn and kept to a minimum for the preservation of the preparedness from Gotenhafen to Szczecin. The captain of the ship was Captain Petersen (about 63 years old). Two young captains of merchant ships were also stationed as captains about five days earlier. The seaman's staff was largely replaced by Croats and consisted only in key positions (Btsm. Etc.) from Germans.
2. It was envisioned that the *W.G.* would be in the union with *Hansa* as the second transport ship. As transport manager, Kapt. Z.S. Neitzel was in command. On the *W.G.* was the military leader Korv. Kapt. Tooth.
3. A few days before departure, a meeting was held in which Kapt. Z.S. Neitzel was present. Kapt. Z.S.N. informed me that organizational questions have been discussed in the first place, and that *W.G. / Hansa* had some escort vehicles provided (which so far they were not ensured).
4. Before losing the *W.G.*, three telephone conversations with Korv. Catch, Schulz were noted. I got word, along with the Torpedoboot *Löwe* and *TF 1* with the *W.G.* that the *Hansa* was ready. (*Hansa* was at Gotehnafen-Reede and had to take on several thousand refugees there.) On the phone, I had a confirmation that I was to sail westwards on the deep-water path. The goal should first be Stettin. I had not received written or oral instructions concerning my attitude towards the ship's management, the behavior on the bridge, zig-zag course, navigation light setting, etc., by Kapt. Schulz. About the submarine, I knew from several conversations with comrades, that at the moment before we sailed, no submarines were established. I had also assumed that the questionable sea area had been clarified beforehand and a warning would have been issued if a submarine was found.

II. Course of travel and loss.

1. On January 30th, 1945 at 1:00pm, the *W.G.* left from the pier.

At the control station in Gotenhafen, the *W.G.* immediately ran with a convoy for the way to Hela. On passing *Hansa*, I received Kapt. Z.S. Neitzel's message that I should sail off alone. Since *Hansa* had to return and would be cleared in several hours.

2. After turning off the mine guide, I let the *Löwe* and *TF1* come forward on the Stb. and ordered to drive a submarine fuse. (?) This could not be done due to heavy seas. *TF 1* immediately reported tear in the weld, water break, requested dismissal to Gotenhafen. *TF1* was dismissed. FT to F.d.U. made *Löwe* receive the order to stand before *W.G.* to escort her out. However, due to heavy seas this was practically not feasible. *Löwe* made only small advances and fought heavily with the sea.

3. *W.G.* ran 12 sm. The ship was dispatched by two young comrades of the merchant fleet (one of them commanded a torpedoboot and had many of the escorts from Riga, Windau and Memel to Gotenhafen). The captain of the *W.G.*, Captain Petersen, ranked above all. I talked to the captains on the bridge and let her share my experiences.

They told me,

A) They have never zig-zagged,

B) They should be over 12 sm after their instructions because of the mines.

4. At about 9:00pm, I was sitting with the captain of the ship, the 1st Offizer, and one of the young captains. I pointed out to the captain of the ship that I thought it would be better to steer in zigzags. It was explained to me:

(A) The ship could not continue to operate in the long run because the damage point on the screw shackle (resulting from a bomb attack) had only been sufficiently fixed and more of a load could not be exerted. Moreover, for the merchant shipping order, there should be no more than 12 sm;

(B) The point would not be as the ship was too heavy (208m long and weak machines) and the navigation (because of the drift) was even more difficult. Furthermore, it is forbidden to leave the forced paths.

5. During this conversation (around 9:20pm) 3 detonations were carried out in intervals of 2 to 3 seconds. The lights went out. The emergency generator jumped on immediately and ensured sufficient emergency lighting. The ship immediately had about a list of 5 degrees, on the hit side. Fire had not come. The back lay deeper than normal. All the officers met on the bridge. The refugees were instructed to go to upper deck. No panic.

UK connection with torpedo boat *Löwe*. *Löwe* received instruction to throw fright flares. This has not been done. Red stars. Spotlight rescue call to all lights visible on the horizon.

An attempt was made to lower the ship's lifeboats to water. Because of the strong icing of the blocks and because the Croatians of the ship were not present, only about 4-6 boats came to water under the greatest difficulty and use of our soldiers.

During the first 20 minutes, the ship did not do much. Gradually, a panic mood seemed to be brewing. We calmed the people by shouting that the ship had been grounded. I gave orders to the radio room to destroy the key codes. When the port side list increased (about 15 degrees), people became restless again. We told them that the ship would remain floating for several hours. When the port side had reached 25 degrees to 30 degrees and increased faster, we realized that the ship would not float for long. Since, according to my knowledge, most of the rescue means were available (including a huge cutter), I climbed there.

The port side list increased very quickly. The upper deck was soon vertical. Panic. The ship sank very quickly on the side of the vessel with a vertical top deck. I worked myself over the numerous rescue boats, partly floating, to a cutter, in which about 10 people were. We took about 50 people. I brought the cutter to a torpedo boat (*T36*), which was suddenly in our proximity. *Hipper* had also appeared, leaving the accident site soon. I assumed that the *Hipper* would lower all the boats, and then, with the help of the artillery, the U-boat would attack and they would attack the U-boat. He could also have run at a distance of 3-4,000m around the accident site with high speed. The boats, which had been packed in the meantime, could have been reused several times. It is, however, not to be overlooked from here, as the position of *Hipper* soon disappeared. Thousands of people sat on the numerous rescue rafts. Everyone shouted for help.

6. On the *T36*, the commander told me that he had ordered the engines to head for two targets. *T36* had been stopped for 45 minutes and saved who they could. The commander decided to go. Shortly afterwards, he had to avoid a torpedo-strike (by himself). *T36* had taken on 550 people and was overcrowded, with 250 refugees on board, aside from the crew. Further rescue was not possible. *T36* acted on my advice using flares as scare tactics. Shooting with the flak guns was not possible because of icing. *T36* has done excellent and deserves special recognition. Naturally nothing can be reported about the rescue action of the *Löwe*. *Löwe* came to Tb's repeated request to throw depth charges, for some unknown reason, after a very long time.

Remarks:

With the above report Corvette Captain Wilhelm Zahn answered seven questions which the MOK East, on behalf of the Commander-in-Chief of the Navy, addressed to him on February 1st, 1945 after the sinking of the *M/S Wilhelm Gustloff*.

These questions were worded as follows:

1. Who was responsible for the selection and conviction?
2. To what extent was the ship's safe area made available?
3. Who was escort leader?
4. How were commands about zig-zag sailing controlled?
5. What kind of engines were fitted with larger boats?
6. Have devices been used, and which commands have been issued for locating these devices?

7. Were other measures for the defense of submarine hazards ordered?
