

# IS THE \$1,000 SEED REAL?

1st Kings 3:4-5

When most people hear about sowing a thousand dollars to the Kingdom of God they cringe. Sowing a financial seed does not bother many people. However, sowing a thousand dollar seed bothers a multitude of people.

Some people would argue that you shouldn't have to sow a thousand dollars to receive a blessing. They are absolutely right. Some people would debate that sowing a thousand dollars is extreme. They are absolutely right.

Another group of people would state that sowing a thousand dollars is not biblical. These individuals are completely **WRONG**. You **DO NOT** have to sow a thousand dollars to be blessed by God.

Sowing a thousand dollars is an extreme act of faith. However, it is biblical. It is Godly. Most importantly, the thousand dollar seed **GRABS GOD'S ATTENTION**.

## IS IT REAL?

1st Kings 3:4-5

Before you can prove something is real you must find evidence for the claim. 1st Kings 3:4-5 says, "*King Solomon went to Gibeon to offer a sacrifice, because it was the most important place of worship.*

*HE OFFERED A THOUSAND burnt offerings on that alter. While he was at Gibeon, the Lord appeared to him in a dream during the night. God said, "Ask for whatever you want me to give you."*

Reading this scripture provides you with evidence that the thousand dollar seed is **REAL**. In order to understand why the thousand dollar seed meant so much to God you must examine the scripture very carefully. Solomon sowed an uncommon seed that produced uncommon results.

## WHY IS THE \$1,000 SEED UNCOMMON?

God **NEVER** commanded nor instructed Solomon to offer a thousand burnt offerings. Solomon **DECIDED** to offer God a thousand burnt offerings. In the Old Testament burnt offerings were considered as currency. In the Bible every number means something.

The number one thousand (1,000) symbolizes "immensity." "fullness of quantity" or "multitude". It is often used in scripture to specify an **INDEFINITE** quantity. Think about that! When something is indefinite it is **UNLIMITED**.

After Solomon offered God a **THOUSAND** burnt offerings, what happened? God appeared to him in a dream and said "*ask for **WHATEVER** you want.*" God did not limit Solomon's opportunity. God wrote Solomon a blank check. Imagine that.

The thousand dollar seed gave Solomon the opportunity to receive an **UNLIMITED SUPPLY** of what he wanted. Galatians 6:7 says, *Be not deceived; God is not mocked: for whatsoever a man soweth, THAT shall he also reap.*" When Solomon sowed a thousand burnt offerings, he did not sow a numerical number. He sowed what the number represented...**AN UNLIMITED SUPPLY!**

Solomon did not ask God for money. He did not ask for wealth. He asked for Wisdom! The thousand burnt offerings Solomon sowed gave him the **OPPORTUNITY** to receive an **UNLIMITED SUPPLY** of what he asked for... Wisdom.

1st Kings 3:11-12 says, *"So God said to him, "You did not ask for a long life, or riches for yourself, or the death of your enemies. Since you asked for Wisdom to make the right decisions, I will do what you asked. I will give you wisdom and understanding that is GREATER THAN ANYONE HAS HAD IN THE PAST OR WILL HAVE IN THE FUTURE."*

Solomon walked with **UNLIMITED WISDOM** because he sowed an **UNLIMITED SEED**. If you decide to sow a thousand dollar seed to the Kingdom of God you will have the opportunity to receive an **UNLIMITED SUPPLY** of what you **ASKED** for. Is the thousand dollar seed real? Yes it is. Will it produce an uncommon harvest? Yes it will.

If you choose not to sow a thousand dollar seed to the Kingdom of God the Lord will not be angry with you. However, the people who choose to sow a thousand dollars to the Kingdom of God will reap a uncommon blessing. Solomon lived an uncommon life because he had the faith to do what was uncommon.
