## SERVING GOD UNDER PRESSURE

Luke 1:26-38

Mary was chosen by God! Mary is the birth mother of Jesus. Mary was chosen to be supernaturally impregnated by the Holy Spirit. Her assignment was to carry and birth King Jesus.

To be chosen for this amazing assignment **SEEMS** wonderful. However, Mary faced a major problem. Mary was engaged to Joseph. The Holy Spirit impregnated her **BEFORE** she married Joseph.

A woman who was pregnant and unmarried was considered to be disgraceful during the era of Christ.

The angel Gabriel went to Mary and told her that she was blessed and favored by God. When the angel told Mary what the Lord wanted her to do she accepted the assignment **IN-SPITE** of her situation.

In Luke 1:38 Mary said, "*I am the servant of the Lord. Let this happen to me as you say!*" Mary understood the dilemma she was putting herself under. Unlike most people, Mary was willing to carry the pressure of expectation.

Mary did not have to accept the responsibility **PRESENTED** to her. She could of rejected the responsibility, but she didn't. Mary understood this vital wisdom key. **GOD ONLY DEPENDS ON THE PEOPLE HE CHOOSES!**

In-spite of Mary's dilemma of being pregnant and unmarried, the pressure of pleasing God compelled her to endure the persecution aimed at her.

When God chooses you to fulfill an assignment, He is **DEPENDING** on you to further His purpose.

Knowing that God is depending on you will cause you to feel the pressure of pleasing Him. This type of pressure will **NOT** weigh you down. It will **NOT** oppress you. It will **NOT** hurt you.

It will **NOT** depress you. This type of pressure will make you **DETERMINED**. The pressure of expectation will compel you to overcome obstacles, follow through on instructions and ignore distractions.

If God has chosen you to do something, the task may seem difficult, it may look impossible but do not allow the size of the task to blind you to the size of your God. If
