

# THERE ARE TWO TYPES OF PEOPLE

(Matthew 20:1-16)

I am not making a general statement. I am making a specific statement. Everyone on the earth falls into one of these two categories. These two categories explain why there is a **DIFFERENCE** between the rich and the poor.

The wise and the foolish. The righteous and the un-righteous. The lazy and the laborers. There are only two types of people on the earth.

● **THE PEOPLE WHO MAKE SOMETHING HAPPEN!**

AND

● **THE PEOPLE WHO WAIT FOR SOMETHING TO  
HAPPEN!**

People who make things happen will always have **MORE** than the people who wait for things to happen. Here are some examples that will strengthen your understanding.

- People who **MAKE** things happen do not wait for someone to give them a job. They create their own opportunities.
- People who **WAIT** for things to happen will be content with taking less while everyone else is striving to receive the best.
- People who **MAKE** things happen will **NOT** wait to get what they want. They will **PURSUE** what they want.
- People who **WAIT** for things to happen will never be first in anything. They will be last in everything.
- People who **MAKE** things happen will always be the one who leads instead of the one who follows.

# DO YOU MAKE THINGS HAPPEN OR DO YOU WAIT FOR THINGS TO HAPPEN?

## THE ENDING RESULTS

(Matthew 20:1-15)

In this parable you will notice two types of people. The person who **MAKES** things happen and the person who **WAITS** for things to happen. The one who **MAKES** things happen increases his wealth and productivity. The owner in this story **DID NOT WAIT** for the people to come to him. He went to them.

In Matthew 20:3 the owner went to the marketplace and recruited more workers. He saw an opportunity and took advantage of it. The owner **DID NOT WAIT** for an opportunity. He **PURSUED** an opportunity.

The owner in this story was a mover and a shaker. His disposition and mentality made him a leader. While

everyone else lacked, he prospered. When you are a person who **MAKES** things happen prosperity will follow you.

The scripture also shows us a group of people who **WAITS FOR THINGS TO HAPPEN**. In Matthew 20:6 the owner saw a group of people standing around the marketplace doing nothing and he asked them, "*why did you stand here all day doing nothing?*" They answered, "*no one gave us a job.*"

These people wasted countless hours of their day because they were **WAITING** on something they could of made happen for themselves. These people were very passive. Their passivity caused them to live a life of **LACK** and **DEPENDENCY!**

The message that Jesus taught us in the scripture is very clear. **YOU** decide what comes to you. If you want more, do more. The passivity of people keeps them delayed and eventually denied.

Remember, there are only two types of people. Those who **MAKE** things happen and those who **WAIT** for things to happen. Which category do you fall into?
