

UNDERSTANDING YOUR KINGDOM ASSIGNMENTS

In the Kingdom, God will give you multiple assignments to fulfill. The purpose of these assignments are to advance the will of God on the earth. These assignments are not focused around what you want to do.

They are given to you based on what you have the **ABILITY** to do. When God created you, He blessed you with gifts, talents and a unique personality for the purpose of completing His will.

Each individual is given multiple assignments during three stages of their life; **ADOLESCENCE, TEENS AND ADULTHOOD**. Your assignments will be in a designated **PLACE**. It will cater to a particular **PERSON** or **GROUP**

OF PEOPLE and it will cause you to **DO** something meaningful.

Most people live their entire lives without understanding their divine assignments. It is very important to understand that your divine assignments are different from your personal responsibilities.

Managing personal responsibilities will make **YOU** responsible for maintaining what you have. Fulfilling divine assignments will **OBLIGATE GOD** to provide for you.

For example, if **YOU** decide to have children, God is **NOT** obligated to provide for your children. You are! However, if God anointed you to start a ministry it is **HIS** responsibility to provide what you need. Please keep this in mind.

**GOD PROVIDES FOR HIS PURPOSE, NOT
YOUR PLANS.**

(Proverbs 19:21 says, “Many are the plans in a person’s heart, but it is the Lord’s purpose that prevails.”)

ANALYZING THE THREE STAGES OF DIVINE ASSIGNMENTS

ADOLESCENCE:

Jeremiah 1:4-6 says, “The Lord spoke his word to me saying: Before I made you in your mother’s womb, I chose you. “Before you were born, I set you apart for a special work. I appointed you as a prophet to the nations.” Then I said, “But Lord God, I don’t know how to speak. I am only a **BOY.**”

Do not discount a child’s youth. Their youth should not be squandered on playing video games, watching television and playing with friends.

A child does not have the right or authority to decide what neighborhood they want to live in. The **PLACE** a child resides in is where their divine assignment is located.

The family that the child was birthed into are the **PEOPLE** they are assigned to help and learn from.

The gifts that God has blessed this child with are the things they are assigned to **GIVE**. Every person is born into a different situation because God has given everyone unique assignments. Jeremiah was born during a time when Jerusalem turned against God.

The Lord positioned Jeremiah in the **RIGHT PLACE**, with the **RIGHT** people and with the **RIGHT** gifts to fulfill His purpose. If you were not born in the best situation it does not mean you were **VOID** of completing divine assignments.

Jeremiah was assigned to do something great in a distressed situation. If you have children, God has called them to complete His assignment. **ALLOW THEM TO GROW WHERE GOD WANTS THEM TO GO!**

TEENS:

1st Samuel 17:55 says, "When Saul saw David go out to meet Goliath, Saul asked Abner, commander of the army, "Abner who is that **YOUNG** man's father?" Abner answered, "As surely as you live, my king, I don't know."

At the time that David fought Goliath he was a teenager. Theologians believe that David was between the ages of thirteen and fifteen years old. Fighting Goliath was David's **KINGDOM** assignment. In 1st Samuel 16:13 David was anointed to be the next king of Israel by the Prophet Samuel.

He was destined to be a king. In order to understand how David's Kingdom assignment interlocked with his anointing you must read 1st Samuel 17:25 very carefully. The scripture says, "They said, "Look at this man! He keeps coming out to challenge Israel. The king will give much money to whoever kills him. He will also let whoever kills him **MARRY HIS DAUGHTER**. And his father's family will not have to pay taxes in Israel."

In a Kingdom culture, kings are **NOT** elected. They are **NOT** commissioned. A person becomes a king by being **RELATED** to the royal family. If David wouldn't of fought Goliath, he could not have married the king's daughter.

Marrying the king's daughter **POSITIONED** him to be **APPOINTED** as the next king of Israel. The Kingdom assignments that are distributed to teenagers are centered around **POSITIONING**. This may include going to a specialized school, partaking in special training, receiving uncommon mentorship, etc.

As a teenager, David's kingdom assignment was to **GET IN POSITION** to be the next king of Israel. The Kingdom assignment that a teenager carries upon their life equips them to follow the will of God as an adult.

ADULTHOOD:

When you examine the life of Jesus in the four Gospels of the New Testament you will discover the Kingdom assignments that He was expected to fulfill as an adult.

Jesus was assigned to impact the **EARTH (PLACE)**. John 6:38 says, *"I came down from heaven to do what God wants me to do, not what I want to do."* The **GROUP OF PEOPLE** whom Jesus was **ASSIGNED** to were the twelve disciples.

Many people believe that Jesus was assigned to the masses but this is not true. Jesus did not spend most of His time with the masses, He spent it with the disciples. Matthew 10:1-15 shows us how He delegated pertinent responsibilities to these twelve disciples. He was only assigned to mentor, train and develop **THESE** men.

The things that Jesus was assigned to do was bring the Kingdom of God back to earth and redeem humanity from the curse of sin and death. Matthew 4:17 shows us the dominant **MESSAGE** that Jesus was sent here to preach. He was to preach the Kingdom of God.

Matthew 16:21 shows us the primary thing Jesus had to **DO** while He was on the earth. He had to die on the cross. The Kingdom assignments that you are destined to

carry as an adult will be centered around you being **INFLUENTIAL**.

Jesus assignments as an adult was based on one thing; **INFLUENCE**. His message **INFLUENCED** the people He encountered and His sacrifice **INFLUENCED** the people who were lost. When you understand how to identify your Kingdom assignments, your life will be full of purpose.

RECAP

- In your adolescence, your Kingdom assignments are centered around you **LEARNING** from the people around you and **HELPING** the people who need you.
- As a teenager, your Kingdom assignments are centered around you being **TRAINED** and **MENTORED** by institutions and individuals so you can be positioned to walk in your destiny.

- As an adult, your Kingdom assignments are centered around you being in the seat of **INFLUENCE** so you can correct and change what is wrong.
