Despite all of the above, God has assigned them to your life to bless you. When an enemy is assigned to bless you it is because they have something you **NEED**. DAVID NEEDED GOLIATH

David was destined to become Israel's king. However, before he could take the throne he had to fight Goliath. David **NEEDED** Goliath to enter the palace so he could be in the presence of royalty.

Goliath was terrorizing the Israelite community. Everyone in the community was afraid of him. The king of Israel offered a reward to anyone who was willing to kill Goliath.

1st Samuel 17:25 says, "They said, "Look at this man! He keeps coming out to challenge Israel. The king will give much money to whoever kills him. He will also let whoever kills him marry his daughter. And his father's family will not have to pay taxes in Israel."

Goliath was the enemy who was assigned to bless David. The reward that was attached to this battle was the entrance to David's destiny. When David defeated Goliath

he instantly became royalty because he was able to marry the king's daughter.

One divine enemy, one divine battle took David from poverty to wealth. God has a divine enemy He wants you to fight. This divine enemy is not sent to defeat you. He is sent to **PROMOTE** you.

DIVINE ENEMIES CARRY DIVINE REWARDS

As you are living in this life, you will have different types of enemies. However, the difference between divine enemies and everyone else is the reward that is attached to them. Every enemy that comes against you does not have a reward attached to them.

Most times, nothing is attached. However, there will be a moment when you will face a giant. This enemy may be big and strong but the reward attached to it is great.

WHAT ARE DIVINE REWARDS?
