

KINGDOM EMPOWERMENT

Mathew 6:19-20

The country of the Kingdom of God wants to empower you with resources. When you have resources you can accomplish more, achieve more and make a difference in people's lives.

The Kingdom of God is like yeast. Wherever the Kingdom of God is manifested there will be great influence. This specific type of influence will make a drastic difference in people's lives.

Kingdom influence changes a persons perspective, infiltrates the heart, shifts their behavior and **TRANSFORMS** their lives. Kingdom influence is exhibited through the utilization of **DIVINE RESOURCES**.

DIVINE RESOURCES are different than everyday resources. The kind of resources that you will utilize will be the same as everyday resources like water, food, clothes, money, etc. However, the **WAY** you attain these resources is what makes them divine.

Divine resources last longer than everyday resources. They are protected by God because they were given by His country. People cannot steal them because they come from the storehouse of Heaven.

Mathew 6:19-20 says, "Don't store treasures for yourselves here on earth where moths and rust will destroy them and thieves can break in and steal them. But store your treasures in heaven where they cannot be destroyed by moths or rust and where thieves cannot break in and steal them."

Remember when King Jesus fed five thousand people with two fish and five loaves of bread? Mathematically, this does not make sense. It is impossible to feed five thousand people and have left overs with this amount of food.

The **ONLY** reason these resources were more than enough were because they came from the Kingdom of God. When the Kingdom provides you with **DIVINE RESOURCES** they will do more than meets the eye.

Divine resources empower you to do more with less. Divine resources will last beyond its shelf life. Divine resources fulfill your needs. The Kingdom does not utilize human logic. It applies divine wisdom.

If you are a Kingdom citizen receiving divine resources is your inheritance. Psalm 144:12-15 says, "Let our sons in their youth grow like plants. Let our daughters be like the decorated stones in the Temple. Let our barns be filled with crops of all kinds.

Let our sheep in the fields have thousands and tens of thousands of lambs. Let our cattle be strong. Let no one break in. Let there be no war, no screams in our streets. Happy are those who are like this; happy are the people whose God is the Lord."

Do not worry yourself of natural resources. Natural resources will run dry and not fulfill you. A limited amount of divine resources will go farther than an abundance of earthly resources. Remember, divine resources are the same as natural resources but the **WAY** you receive them is different.

If you have to chase after things and invest your own effort and strength to get these resources they are not divine. **DIVINE RESOURCES ARE ADDED UNTO YOU** per Mathew 6:33.

Mathew 6:33 says, "But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you." When things are added unto you they are **GIVEN** to you by other sources **WITHOUT** self effort.
