

WHERE DO THE KINGDOM LAWS OF GOD COME FROM?

Mathew 16:19

King Jesus teaches us about the laws of the Kingdom of God in the New Testament. Mathew 16:19 says, "And I will give unto thee the KEYS of the kingdom of heaven: and whatsoever thou shalt bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever thou shalt loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven."

The word keys in this context of scripture means laws. After Peter was shown the true identity of Jesus he was gifted with the keys of the Kingdom. These keys gave Peter authority in the earth. With these keys Peter could bind and loose anything he wanted on the earth.

The Kingdom of God is a Country ran by a divine government. The essential part of every government,

whether natural or spiritual are **LAWS**. Laws empower people with authority. Police officers are given authority in cities and states because they enforce laws.

Human Resources Directors are given authority at the workplace because they create and enforce laws. Politicians carry authority in their state because they influence the creation of law.

When King Jesus gave Peter the keys (laws) to the Kingdom He gave him authority in the earth. When you have been given the laws of God's Kingdom you have been given **POWER AND AUTHORITY** in the earth.

This is where the concept of the Kingdom laws of God comes from. Before King Jesus handed the keys to Peter He established the church to be built on a certain type of rock. A rock that could not be moved by the gates of hell. A rock that could stand the test of time. A rock that men could not debate or eradicate.

Matthew 16:18 says, "And I say also unto thee, That thou art Peter, and upon this rock I will build my church; and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it."

This rock is called the Kingdom laws of God. The church is suppose to stand and build its community on the **LAWS** of the Kingdom. If the church actually fulfilled the command of King Jesus it would be the most powerful institution on the earth.

WHAT IS A KINGDOM LAW?

Ecclesiastes 8:4 says, "What the king says is law; no one tells him what to do." A Kingdom law is a **COMMAND**, **ORDER, DECREE, REQUIREMENT, MANDATE, RULING, COVENANT, INSTRUCTION** or an **INJUNCTION**.

Anytime you see a phrase or a scripture in the Bible that is correlated with the above references it is a Kingdom law. With that being said it is hundreds and maybe thousands

of laws that are documented in the Bible. Remember, the **ENTIRE** Bible is authorized and approved by King Jesus.

If you ask the Holy Spirit to reveal to you the Kingdom laws of God you will be amazed at what you find. You cannot read the Bible in your own strength and discover these laws. These laws must be revealed to you by God Himself!

Mathew 13:11 says, "Jesus answered, "You have been chosen to know the secrets about the kingdom of heaven, but others cannot know these secrets."

The laws of the Kingdom of God are treasures. In order to find these treasures God has to give you the wisdom to identify them. It is easy to learn religion. However, it is hard to discover the Kingdom.

Religion is readily found because it was created by men. However, the Kingdom is hard to find because it was founded by God. Remember this wisdom key.

ONLY THE CREATOR CAN EXPLAIN HIS CREATION!

When you study the Bible (Constitution) do not view it as a religious book. Do not study it merely as a devotional. The Bible is the **CONSTITUTION** of the Kingdom of God. It is a **LEGAL** and binding agreement between men, God and the earth.

Whenever a Kingdom command (law) is violated, either men feels the consequence, earth experiences the trouble or God feels the pain. Think about it. When Adam fell from Dominion in Genesis Chapter 3, what happened? Adam dealt with the consequences of poverty. The earth experienced the trouble of evilness and God felt the pain of disobedience.

These are the effects of the Kingdom laws of God. These secrets (the Kingdom laws of God) impact the most important aspects of our lives. It impacts the soul of a

person, the territory of our existence and the Lord of our lives.

Learning the origin of the Kingdom laws of God will help you respect its importance, significance and impact in your life.
