

# THE DESTINATION OF AN ENEMY

Psalm 57:6

If you are an enemy to someone you have an appointed destination scheduled for **YOU**. If you have enemies they have an appointed destination for **THEM**. Whatever side you're on, every enemy has an appointment with a punishment.

## DEFINITION OF AN ENEMY

An enemy is someone who attacks **FIRST**. The person who strikes first becomes eligible to receive the consequences of an enemy. The consequences of an enemy is falling on the blade of their **OWN** sword.

Psalm 57:6 says, "They set a trap for me. I am very worried. They dug a pit in my path, but they fell into it themselves."

The plans an enemy devises will boomerang back on them. This is why God instructed us not to take revenge on other people. Romans 12:19 says, "Dearly beloved, avenge not yourselves, but rather give place unto wrath: for it is written, Vengeance is mine; I will repay, saith the Lord."

When the Lord gave us this command He was **PROTECTING** us from the judgment of an enemy. Our Lord decided to take the burden on our behalf in destroying our enemies so we won't become enemies ourselves.

Despite who comes against you or attacks you, God got you! His vengeance on your enemies frees you from the thoughts of revenge and the actions of anger.

## DON'T DO IT

As tempting as it may be to deceive, manipulate, hurt, mislead, cheat, lie, hurt, steal or rob, **DON'T DO IT**. The adjectives above are actions of attacking. When you

exhibit these actions against other people you are their enemy.

## DEFENDING YOURSELF

When you have an enemy, **DEFEND** yourself. Do not attack them with cruel words and harsh actions. Pray for them. As Kingdom citizens our prayers are our weapons against our enemies.

Think about it. If vengeance is the Lord's isn't our responsibility to give our enemies to God so He can fulfill His word? Yes it is. When you give your enemies over to God, He will take vengeance!

Mathew 5:44 says, "But I say unto you, Love your enemies, bless them that curse you, do good to them that hate you, and pray for them which despitefully use you, and persecute you."

Praying for your enemies is not optional if you are a Kingdom citizen. It is a requirement. A requirement that **ACTIVATES** the vengeance of the Lord. Your weapon against your enemy is the Lord's promise, **USE IT!**

It is the best defense weapon anyone can have. Why? Because His promises never fail, never come back void and always fulfills itself.

Becoming someone's enemy is an easy way to self destruct. When people choose to become your enemy they will soon self destruct. You cannot control what other people do. However, you can control your actions. Do not become a casualty to your own evil plans by becoming another person's enemy.
