PLEASURE OR PRINCIPLE

Genesis chapter 39 through chapter 41

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Asking the question what is more important, pleasure or principle is easy to answer. However, being faced with this option in the midst of temptation is difficult. There is a huge difference between pleasure and principle.

Pleasure is a **SELF** fulfilled desire. Principles are **VALUES** you stand by. In the presence of comfort most people will promote how they are a principled person. They will explain how they are committed to their values. However, this statement means nothing until it has been tested.

Very few people choose principle over pleasure when they are in the midst of being tested or tempted. You may be thinking, how does this topic relate to ministry? The answer is simple. Many preachers have fallen from grace because they chose pleasure over principle. An abundance of churches have lost their influence with the community because they chose pleasure over principle. Choosing pleasure over principle will give you short term gratification, yet long term regret.

Choosing principle over pleasure will give you short term pain, yet long term honor. Nelson Mandela chose principle over pleasure. He suffered for twenty seven years in prison. However, he is still honored and admired even in death.

Joseph chose principle over pleasure. He suffered for over five years. He was a slave and a prisoner because he refused to compromise his values. Joseph decided to honor his master instead of receiving sexual pleasure from Potiphar's wife.

Joseph's decision to choose principle over pleasure positioned him to be exalted by God and become the 2nd in command over Egypt. Reference Genesis chapter 39 through 41. Are you a person who is willing to give up immediate gratification for long term honor?

A LIFE OF PLEASURE

A life of pleasure **WITHOUT** principle produces fun yet frustration. It creates happiness, yet discontentment. It brings a smile, yet regret. It creates satisfaction, yet sadness. It exudes energy, yet mental depression.

A life of pleasure is misleading. Many ministry leaders have fallen on the alter of pleasure, losing more than they realized. Out of respect, I will not mention the ministries and ministers who have been disgraced over the years. However, mega ministries and ministers have lost what God gave them because they chose pleasure over principle.

Ask God to prepare your heart to stand the test and trials of life so you can choose to live a principled life. Start now to equip yourself with the **VALUES** of the Kingdom of God so you can be ready when these tests occur.
