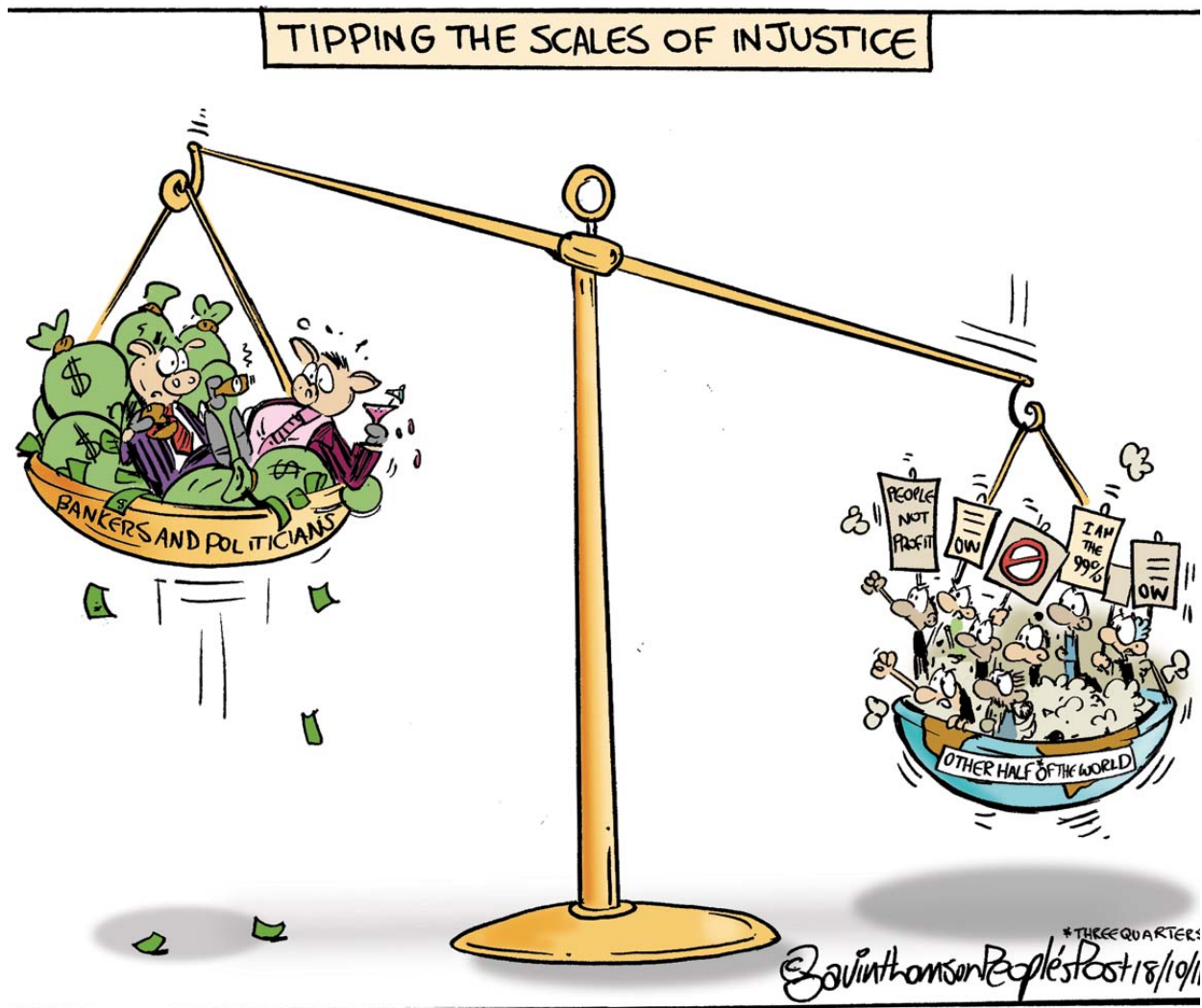
## PROTESTING IS A DEMONSTRATION OF RIGHTEOUS ANGER!

With all of the injustice that is invading our country, protesting is necessary. Be proud to protest! Keep protesting. Protesting gets the attention of those who refuse to listen. Protesting reminds people what you are unwilling to agree with.



Protesting is our Constitutional right. When people hear the cries of protesters they become alarmed. When God hears the cries of protesters He becomes **ANGRY**. Proverbs 11:1 says, *"A false balance is abomination to the Lord: but a just weight is his delight."*

A false balance is the illusion of fairness but the reality of inequality. It is giving crumbs to the poor while the rich have a feast yet, promoting the message everyone eats. It is the misconception that black people have made progress



when our circumstances shows us otherwise. God is not angry with protesters. He is angry with the injustice people are protesting. King Jesus is a just judge. He is fair and righteous. When He sees biased, racism, classism, etc taking place He is disgusted. Our Constitution (Bible) teaches us that it is acceptable

to be angry as long as we do not sin in the process. Ephesians 4:26 says, *“When you are angry, do not sin, and be sure to stop being angry before the end of the day.”*

The type of anger God is referring to is called **INDIGNATION**. It is an outcry for help against insults, offenses and injustice. In the Kingdom of God protesting is considered to be a demonstration of **RIGHTEOUS ANGER**! Be proud when you are protesting against injustice. Be proud when you stand for what is right. Be proud when you speak against evilness.

Why? Because the Lord is pleased. **YOU** are the agents of change against injustice. **YOU** are the voice of conviction when evil people want to shut you down. **YOU** are the heartbeat of those who are scared to speak.

When God is before you, who can come against you? No one. God stands before protesters. I know you may not see change right away but like anything else change does not come quickly. It comes over time. A wall is not torn down when you hit it once. It's torn down when you **REPEATEDLY** hit it.
