ARE YOU MISSING YOUR DELIVERANCE?

Exodus 3:7-10

God hears the cries of His people. He sees the pain of His people. He watches the trouble His people go through. He listens to the prayers of righteous people. God **ALWAYS** sends help to deliver you from the trouble you are going through.

Unfortunately, many people miss their deliverance. People neglect to receive deliverance not because they do not want it. They **CANNOT** recognize it.

People's lack of understanding of deliverance prevents them from being delivered. If you believe deliverance is a service at your church you will miss being delivered. If you believe deliverance is falling out in the floor when the preacher lays hands on you, you will miss your deliverance.

Deliverance is far from that. When God chooses to deliver you from your troubles He will **SEND A PERSON TO SAVE YOU FROM YOUR TROUBLES**.

This individual may not be who you think. They may not have the look you expect. They may not come from the background you approve of. They may not come from your generation. They may not be as polished as you prefer.

However, they are **EXACTLY WHAT YOU NEED** to get out of bondage. The person **GOD** sends has the specialized knowledge to save you from your troubles. They have the right amount of energy to bring you out of bondage.

They have the exact amount of strength to solve your problems. This person has received a specific type of

grace to handle your trouble. Because of the warped understanding people have about deliverance they miss their savior. They usually are looking for an it, instead of a who. When you ask God to deliver you from your trouble look for a **PERSON**, not for a thing.

THE DELIVERERS

The Israelites were enslaved for four hundred years. Generations of men and women were trapped under the control of Pharaoh. They suffered the agony of pain, torture and disrespect on a daily basis. During their tumultuous time in slavery they called out to God for help.

They pleaded to the Lord for some type of relief. They were begging for God to save them. Exodus 3:7-10 says, "The Lord said, "I have seen the troubles my people have suffered in Egypt, and I have heard their cries when the Egyptian slave masters hurt them. I am concerned about their pain, and I have come down to save them from the Egyptians.

I will bring them out of that land and lead them to a good land with lots of room—a fertile land. It is the land of the Canaanites, Hittites, Amorites, Perizzites, Hivites, and Jebusites.

I have heard the cries of the people of Israel, and I have seen the way the Egyptians have made life hard for them. So now I am sending you to the king of Egypt. Go! Bring my people, the Israelites, out of Egypt!"

God had a plan to deliver the Israelites from slavery. Moses was the vehicle the Lord chose to utilize to carry out this initiative.

King Jesus was sent by God to deliver the world from sin and death. God the Father knew He needed a deliverer to save His children. The deliverer He sent was His son. Luke 19:9 says, "Jesus said to him, "Salvation has come to this house today, because this man also belongs to the family of Abraham."

ARE YOU MISSING YOUR DELIVERANCE?

Are you missing your deliverance because you are waiting for a thing to save you? Are you missing your deliverance because you have neglected the **PEOPLE** God sent to your life.

It is vital to understand how deliverance works. God sends people with the skills, anointing and capability to save you from your trouble. God heard your prayers and seen your problems. However, He is sending someone with the answers to solve your problems.

Ask the Holy Spirit to give you discernment to comprehend who is God sent. Remember, God will **NOT** send someone you may enjoy. He will send the one who is **EQUIPPED** to get the job done. Your deliverer is not assigned to get your approval. They are assigned to get you **OUT OF TROUBLE**. Your deliverance is dependent on your **ACKNOWLEDGMENT** of your deliverer!
