The solution to ending oppression is simple. However, the process can be daunting depending on your **FAITH**. Oppression will only end when you become powerful and are not dependent on other people and their resources.

For some people this may be easy and for others it may be hard. However, that decision is dependent on your **FAITH**. Religion cannot deliver you from oppression. As a matter of fact, religion oppresses you. Religion keeps you dependent on their system of spirituality.

Religion wants you to depend on the church for your guidance. Religion wants you to depend on their leaders for direction. Religion wants you to depend on its

resources for your help. Religion preaches dependency on God. However, they promote dependency on men.

## **HOW BIG IS YOUR FAITH?**

Mathew 21:22 says, "And all things, whatsoever ye shall ask in prayer, believing, ye shall receive." To alleviate yourself from the system of oppression you have to **TRUST** God to give you everything you need.

This is easier said than done because people have not learned how to trust God. Trusting God means being willing to obey His initial instruction **WITHOUT** knowing the ending result. Leaning on your faith may lead you to places that are unfamiliar and uncomfortable for you.

However, it will never position you to be without adequate provision. The places God leads you to will always aid you in ending oppression. The people God sends toward you will aid you in ending oppression. If you

can lean on your faith and not your intellect God will add **ALL** things unto you.

## HERE'S HOW

Mathew 6:33 says, "But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you."

Faith is the **LANGUAGE** of the Kingdom of God. You cannot seek what you do not understand. When you are reading the Bible, its words and instructions are to be obeyed by your actions and **MANIFESTED WITH YOUR FAITH**.

Obedience to the Kingdom Constitution (Bible) is your faith on display. The Kingdom of God responds with prosperity when it sees faith actively demonstrated. To end oppression depend on the Kingdom of God to give you its provision so you won't have to depend on other people's resources. Your faith is the catalyst to making this happen. If you honor these four steps and repeat them continuously you will **END** the system of oppression in your life.

- 1. **SEEK** the Kingdom of God and live righteously.
- OBEY the voice and instruction of the Holy Spirit and King Jesus.
- RECEIVE the provision and goodness that is being added unto you.
- 4. **WATCH** the cycle of oppression gradually decrease as your prosperity increases.
