It will keep you safe **AND**  fulfilled. The right opportunity will bring the best out of you.Proverbs 3:5 says, "*Trust in the Lord with all thine heart;* And lean not unto thine own understanding."

People's intellect will always gravitate to what makes sense. However, everything that makes sense is not always right. When the Lord speaks He does not say what makes sense to our natural mind. He speaks what is righteous to our spirits.

For example, does it make sense to pray for those who despitefully use you? No. Does it make sense to turn the other cheek when someone has hurt you? No. This is why you cannot lean on your own understanding but you have to **TRUST** the Lord.
