Can you be poor in the Kingdom?

Mathew 9:29

The Kingdom of God is a country that is saturated and decorated in **WEALTH**. It is the epitome of luxury and splendor. It is the place where **ALL** goodness comes from. With the wealth that is stored in the Kingdom of God, is it possible for its citizens to experience poverty in such a place?

The answer is yes! Poverty is not circumstantial in the Kingdom. It is a choice. **YOU** choose to be impoverished as a Kingdom citizen. God's country provides every opportunity for you to prosper and be in good health. However, if you do not maximize on the opportunity you will be poor.

KINGDOM POVERTY

The opportunity mentioned above is understood by very few. Poverty in the Kingdom is not a lack of money or resources. Poverty in the Kingdom of God is a **LACK OF FAITH!**

Lacking faith produces poverty. Faith is **CURRENCY** in the Kingdom of God. In order to receive anything from God's Kingdom, faith is **REQUIRED!**

Mustard seed faith is the bare minimum a person needs to have to make a transaction in the Kingdom. Mustard seed faith is equivalent to a one dollar transaction on the earth. You can get something but not much.

The Kingdom Constitution outlines what you cannot do if you lack or go **WITHOUT** faith. Refer to the two Kingdom statues below as examples.

Hebrews 11:6 says, "*But **WITHOUT** faith it is impossible to please him: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and that he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him.*"

Mathew 9:29 says, "*Then touched he their eyes, saying, **ACCORDING** to your faith be it unto you.*"

These two scriptures explains and justifies how limited your transactions in the Kingdom will be if you lack faith. In the Kingdom, you will only receive **ACCORDING TO THE MEASURE** of your faith.

The scenario that strongly highlights Kingdom poverty is when Jesus went to His hometown. King Jesus, the Anointed One, the Savior of the world, the Alpha and Omega was **LIMITED** in His ability to perform miracles because the people of His home town **LACKED FAITH**.

Mathew 13:57-58 says, "*And they were offended in him. But Jesus said unto them, A prophet is not without honour, save in his own country, and in his own house. And he did not many mighty works there because of their unbelief.*"

The people's unbelief caused them to lack receiving miracles from God. Their **POOR** faith caused them to **LACK** receiving abundant results. Is this you? Is your lack of faith causing your prayers to go unanswered? That's what poverty does. Poverty causes you to lose hope in what has the ability to help you.

IT'S NOT GOD'S FAULT

God's promises are real. His word is His bond. He is not a man that can lie. If you are not seeing results from the Kingdom Constitution (Bible) it is not God's fault. It's yours! Building your faith is your responsibility. Protecting your faith is your task.

King Jesus told Simon Peter that it is his responsibility to guard his faith (*wealth*). In the Kingdom your faith is your wealth. Luke 22:31-32 says, "*And the Lord said, Simon, Simon, behold, Satan hath desired to have you, that he may sift you as wheat: But I have prayed for thee, that thy faith fail not: and when thou art converted, strengthen thy brethren.*"

God is not taking responsibility of caring for your **FAITH**. If you do not guard it, build it and develop it you will be **POOR** in God's country.

HOW TO BUILD WEALTH IN THE KINGDOM

Building wealth is the **SAME** as building your faith. Going through the tests and trials with patience and endurance that the Lord puts before you builds your faith (wealth).

Having confidence in God when you cannot understand His ways will build your faith (wealth). Studying and meditating on the Constitution (Bible) will build your faith (wealth).

When God can trust you to handle more problems He will trust you with more resources. As resources are added unto you, your wealth grows and your poverty decreases.

Proverbs 22:2 says, "*The rich and poor meet together: the*

Lord is the maker of them all." In the Kingdom the difference between rich and poor people is their faith!
