Revelation 1:6

KINGS RUN Their **DOMAIN**. They are the example, standard and the model of what their environment is suppose to emulate. You are a King on the earth. You are a Queen on the earth. You are royalty.

This is not an arrogant statement. This is an identity affirmation. Not knowing who you are is detrimental to your progress and purpose.

King Jesus is the King of kings and Lord of lords ([1st Timothy 6:15](#)). He rules the Heavens while we rule the earth. He called us kings and royal priests. Revelation 1:6 says, "[and hath made us kings and priests unto God and his Father; to him be glory and dominion for ever and ever. Amen.](#)" KJV.

IDENTITY CHECK

Knowing who you are and accepting who you are is vital. There is a difference in doing something and being something. People who **DO** something are **NOT** consistent in their ways. They do not have a reputation for being credible in that particular area.

However, **BECOMING** something or somebody is totally different. When you become something or somebody you establish an identity that people **ATTACH** you to. For instance, a boy playing basketball at the playground is identified as having fun. A man who plays in the NBA is considered to be a basketball player.

What you do and who you are is **NOT** the same thing. The difference between the people who do something and those who become something is their **COMMITMENT LEVEL.**

Nelson Mandela didn't just fight to end apartheid. He **BECAME** a freedom fighter, committing his life to the cause. Dr. King didn't just speak against injustice. He **BECAME** the standard of equality and justice for all, committing his life to the cause.

TAKE EARTH'S THRONE

It's time to take the throne on the earth. God has His throne in Heaven. The earth belongs to you. Proverbs 115:16 says, "*Heaven belongs to the Lord, but he gave the earth to people.*" People who believe they are rulers on the earth **SET THE STANDARD** in every environment they enter.

It means to create a climate and environment for others to succeed and prosper. It means to put your personal agenda to the side and to complete God's will.

To rule with humility is to take care of people, trusting that God will take care of you. When you are a king/queen who rules with humility it is very important to understand that people will **NOT** show their appreciation all the time. You may feel used and taken advantage of.

You may feel that you give more than you receive. However, kings in the Kingdom of God do not get their rewards and blessings from the people they rule over. Their blessings and rewards comes from their superior, King Jesus!
