Luke 19:9-10

It's one thing to discover your purpose. However it's another thing to **FLOURISH** in your purpose. It is very possible to know your divine purpose and yet be frustrated because you are not fulfilling it.

UNUSUAL TERRITORY

God gave you unique talents, skills and abilities to solve a problem for other people. When God places you in situations to prosper it will not be a comfortable place. The situation will not be ideal. The people may not be polished in their character and behavior.

It will be unusual territory. During the times your gift and talents were being cultivated and developed you were in environments of safety, nurturing, teaching and coaching. When you have matured into your purpose the Lord takes the training wheels off and brings you into situations and environments where you **BECOME** the light instead of following the light.

ENTER THE DARK SIDE

Your purpose will be fulfilled in places of darkness.

Darkness implies places and situations with **NO** direction, vision, clarity, wisdom, hope, knowledge, life, peace, order, structure and prosperity.

Your purpose thrives where you are **NEEDED**, not where you are wanted! For example, if you have the gift of business administration you belong in an office.

God looks at your area of gifting and decides where you belong. He knows the type of people you need to serve based on your personality, tolerance, patience and DNA makeup.
