HOW DOES GOD ADD ALL THINGS UNTO YOU?

Mathew 6:33

Mathew 6:33 says, "But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you."

Have you ever wondered how the Lord will add all things unto you? If not, it is important to know **HOW** this will happen. When you do not know or understand how something occurs you will show very little appreciation for it.

You will undervalue and lose it. Understanding how the Lord adds things unto you is a profound yet loaded statement. However, it is defined by one word.

POSITION! When you seek the Kingdom and His

righteousness **FIRST** the Lord will **POSITION** you to receive all things.

WHY?

RESOURCES ARE ATTRACTED TO POSITIONS, NOT PEOPLE.

Here's what I mean:

The position of President of the United States of America comes with protection from the secret service. Honor is **ADDED** to them because of the position the President holds. Power is **ADDED** to them because of the position that President holds.

Even though America changes Presidents every four to eight years. The **ADDED** perks stay the same despite the change in personnel because resources are attracted to positions, not people.

If the Lord connects and gives you favor with the right people He is positioning you to have all things added to you. Attaining favor from a wealthy or influential person is a **RELATIONAL POSITION**. Relational positions are built around trust. When people can trust you they give to you. A trustworthy person will always be blessed. Proverbs 28:20.

There are many more examples to reference. However, you get the point. Look at your life. What position has God put you in? When you honor the command of Mathew 6:33 look for God to **POSITION** you!

His positioning is reflective of the Kingdom influence. You can be living in overflow and don't even know. You can be living in the center of God's grace and not realize it.

There are millions of people who are ignorant of this revelation. Their ignorance leaves them regretting what they lost because they didn't realize what they had.

WHAT GOD DID NOT PROMISE

God did not promise that you wouldn't have to work to keep your position. He did not promise that you wouldn't have some tough days. He did not promise that holding the position of privilege will be easy. He said He will add all things unto you.

GOD WILL KEEP HIS PROMISE! However, you must study His wisdom to understand His process!

WHO HAD ALL THINGS ADDED UNTO THEM?

DAVID: When David defeated Goliath he didn't have to worry about money, insignificance, taxes or security. When His **POSITION** changed, His wealth changed.

ESTHER: When Esther became Queen she had no worries. She went from a slave girl, having nothing to a Queen ruling everything. When her **POSITION** changed, her wealth changed.

RUTH: Ruth was a poor servant girl until she met a wealthy man named Boaz in the field. When Boaz married Ruth she went from having not enough to more than enough. When her **POSITION** changed from single to married her wealth changed.

From the examples mentioned above you can see and hopefully understand how God keeps His promise and fulfills His word in Mathew 6:33. Do not lose what God gave you because you cannot see what is in your hand.
