THE EVIDENCE OF THE KINGDOM OF GOD

Isaiah 9:6

The Kingdom of God is a government that Kingdom citizens carry on their shoulders. This government is a culture that produces **RESULTS** everywhere it goes.

Carrying the Kingdom government on your shoulders is not a physical weight. It is a mental weight of accountability and responsibility. When you are shouldering the Kingdom you are a real life example of what God wants to do on the earth.

You are the living epistle men read when they encounter you. You become the standard of what God teaches in the Bible. God takes interest in people who have chosen to carry the Kingdom. His interest propels Him to provide **MIRACLES**, **SIGNS AND WONDERS**.

KING JESUS DID NOT BRING A RELIGION!

Isaiah 9:6 says, "For unto us a child is born, unto us a son is given: and the government shall be upon his shoulder: and his name shall be called Wonderful, Counsellor, The mighty God, The everlasting Father, The Prince of Peace."

When Jesus was prophesied to come to the earth by Isaiah He was destined to bring a government, **NOT** a religion! As being children of the living God and Kingdom citizens we are to model our King. If He carried a government on His shoulders what should we do? The same thing.

Anyone who shoulders the responsibility of carrying their government is called an ambassador.

2nd Corinthians 5:20 says, "Now then we are ambassadors for Christ, as though God did beseech you by us: we pray you in Christ's stead, be ye reconciled to God."

When an American Ambassador travels to another country they do not worry about their lodging, food, etc. Everything they need is already provided to them by their country. Their only responsibility is to **REPRESENT** and speak on the behalf of America.

When an ambassador of America travels to a country like Russia, provision and protection **FOLLOWS** them. In the same sense, this is what happens when Kingdom citizens carry the Kingdom of God on their shoulders. Miracles, signs and wonders follow them.

WHAT DOES THIS MEAN?

Mark 16:16-18 says, "He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned. And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; they shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover."

John 4:48 says, "Then said Jesus unto him, Except ye see signs and wonders, ye will not believe." In these two passages of scriptures we see two things. The **EVIDENCE** that follows a Kingdom citizen and the **REASON** why the evidence is necessary.

The reason miracles, signs and wonders are necessary is because unbelievers **NEED TO SEE** the power of God before they believe in King Jesus because they do not have faith. As Kingdom citizens, we are suppose to minster to the world. Unfortunately, the world needs to **SEE** God's miracles and wondrous works **BEFORE** they accept His message.

The evidence that follows Kingdom citizens are casting out devils, speaking in new tongues, taking up serpents without being hurt and healing the sick. These acts turn a negative into a positive, change people circumstances and transcends the temperature and climate in an environment.

The signs that follow Kingdom citizens is their ability to go into dangerous and toxic environments and create peace. The miracles that follow Kingdom citizens is their ability to go into the hospital and heal the diseases and chronic illnesses of patients. The wonders that follow Kingdom citizens is their ability to change a situation that other people gave up on and leave spectators in amazement, asking how did you do that?

If you are a Kingdom citizen you should be carrying the Kingdom of God with you. Because everywhere the Kingdom goes, miracles, signs and wonders **WILL APPEAR**. You are a change agent. Your government is a powerful entity. Do not consider it to be strange that when you come into a room things begin to change.
