Committee Reports:

Adjutant In lieu of reading of the minutes, they are posted on website, a motion was made to accept minutes as posted.

Finance Officer read detailed report of account balances, checking \$14473.27, Rider down fund \$2874.19, Money market \$4115.17, Charity Account \$2356.18, Poker Run Acct \$5858.24. \$27376.87 total funds available. Motion was made to accept finance report subject to audit, it was properly seconded and no discussion, motion passed.

Asst. Director: December miles 5699.5 and 936 hours. We had 1500.00 in donations as well. Miles, years to date were 16962.3 and 10430 hours. Year to date donation \$34000.00. Asst Direct gave out guardian angel

riders as appreciation awards for the riders that always get their miles and hours inputted to the following people, Vickie Skipper-Compton, Richard Leightner, Martin Leightner, AC Freeborn, and Kam Sons.

Chaplin: Get well cards were sent out. We usually do Blessing of the bikes in January but rain has always been an issue so it will be held in the spring.

Sgt at Arms reported 30 members, 1 guest and \$46.00 + \$5.00 in donations for Rider Down fund

Road Captain: We will not have a ride today due to weather, please whenever you plan a ride please contact the director so an email can be sent out to everyone.

Safety Captain: Please make sure you are checking your tires.

2nd Vice: In December we served Meatball subs, we brought in \$350.00, cost was 123.20, with \$226.30 in proceeds. 38 meals were served, 10 volunteers. Taco Tuesday we brought in \$298.00 cost was \$128.00, with proceeds of \$159.29. 50 meals were served and 12 volunteers. In January we are have Philly cheese steak on the 19th, if you would like to volunteer please be at post for 4:00-4:30pmTaco Tuesday will be on 1/23. On February 16 we have our Chili Cook Off.

Webmaster: Minutes are posted and nothing new yet.

Event Coordinator: We moved our date to September 28, 2024, due to POW/MIA. K-9 Line will be our beneficiary of the poker run again this year.

Quarter Master: We have new shirts w/ the new logo, they are \$30.00 the older shirts are \$15.00.

Membership: 51 lifetime members, 59 renewals, 110 total paid members, 34 pending for a total of 144 members.

Historian: Pictures being taken today and next month for website.

Director: As of February, meeting if you are not paid you will be removed from the rolls. If you renew after that your time will start over. February 24 is going to be casino night at Post 129. We received an envelope at the district meeting for a donation. Kam Sons moved that we buy two tables for their casino night, it was properly seconded, there was no discussion, motion carried. On April 13 there is a poker run for Post 37 and a fun ride April 6 for Post 88. Jan 20th there is a Hillbilly ho-down at post 37 and a celebration of life the same day for Ron Moore. On Jan 21st there will be a celebration of life and ride for Tim Scott Morris, 5th district Sgt @ Arms for ALR at post 117 in Palm Bay. Summit is Feb 1-3rd 2024 and they would like a donation for hospitality room. Vicki Skipper-Compton moved that we donate \$50.00 for the hospitality room, it was properly seconded, there was no discussion, motion passed. The riders also now have junior Riders applications and patches. Riders going to Summit are Ed, Brenda, Vicki, Yvette, Ella Rae, Karen, and Jim. District 5 unity ride is April 24th, and they will have 3 routes. East, West and Central. The East coast will head down to the keys. Let me know if you would like to go.
