Psalm 62:1-12

I wait quietly before God, for my salvation comes from him.

- [2] He alone is my rock and my salvation, my fortress where I will never be shaken.
- [3] So many enemies against one man all of them trying to kill me. To them I'm just a broken-down wall or a tottering fence.
- [4] They plan to topple me from my high position. They delight in telling lies about me. They are friendly to my face, but they curse me in their hearts.
 - [5] I wait quietly before God, for my hope is in him.
 - [6] He alone is my rock and my salvation, my fortress where I will not be shaken.
- [7] My salvation and my honor come from God alone. He is my refuge, a rock where no enemy can reach me.
- [8] O my people, trust in him at all times. Pour out your heart to him, for God is our refuge.

PRAYERS FROM THE PSALMS:

The Book pf Psalms is full of desperate circumstances that the Psalm writer is dealing with in his own daily life. The writer knows that he cannot handle these attacks on his own strength. He needs the grace and healing salvation of God. Psalm 62 v.1 "I wait quietly before God, for my salvation comes from Him". v.2 "He alone is my Rock and my salvation, my fortress where I will never be shaken." v.3 "So many enemies against one man, all of them trying to kill me. To them I'm just a broken-down wall or a tottering fence."

In reading [and praying these Psalms], we see clearly that the person writing the psalm-prayer knows he is out of his element.

During our lifetimes in this world, we go through seasons of frustration, fear, and hopelessness. But the precious point is the fact that God is more than able to take our fear and panic so we can respond in trust and hope.

- v.1 "I wait quietly before God, for my salvation comes from Him."
- v.2 "He alone is my Rock and Salvation, my fortress where I will never be shaken."
- v.3 "They plan to topple me from my high position-They delight in telling lies about me. They are friendly to my face, but they curse me in their hearts."

The writer of these prayers knows what he has to deal with. He knows that he is in a desperate situation that only the Almighty can protect him from.

In all of our lives and experiences, we go down to the depths of darkness when circumstances crumble under our feet. We don't know which way to turn and panic makes the situation worse.

Reading and praying the Psalms can change a panicked person into a person of hope and faith. The world is not paradise. There is God and Satan always in conflict. We are to humble ourselves under Almighty God's almighty hand. Amen







Complete this crossword with names of biblical fathers. Use the references for help, if needed.



What you need:

- Paper
- Clear tape
- Ruler
- Pencil

What you do:

- 1. Tape together at least 3 sheets of paper horizontally.
- 2. Draw a straight line across the center of the long paper. Label dates at regular intervals to keep the information organized. For example, each page you add could represent 10 years.
- 3. Gather information for the timeline. Start with your birth year and memorable events in your life. Interview family members to learn what year they were born and when key things in their life happened. Include notes and photos.
- 4. Add pages as needed. Carefully roll up the timeline to keep for generations to come.
