Work hard at living in peace with others. [15] The eyes of the Lord watch over those who do right his ears are open to their cries for help. [16] But the Lord turns his face against those who do evil he will erase their memory from the earth. [17] The Lord hears his people when they call to him for help. He rescues them from all their troubles.[18] The Lord is close to the brokenhearted, he rescues those who are crushed in spirit. [19] The righteous face many troubles, but the Lord rescues them from each and every one. [20] For the Lord protects them from harm not one of their bones will be broken! [21] Calamity will surely overtake the wicked, and those who hate the righteous will be punished. [22] But the Lord will redeem those who serve him. Everyone who trusts in him will be freely pardoned.
